

Priests Note 40th Anniversaries

Several priests of the Diocese of Rochester will note their 40th anniversary of ordination March 17.

Priests in the ordination class of 1945 are Father L. James Callan, Father James P. Collins, Father Francis R. Davis, Father Edward J. Foy, Father Joseph T. Gaynor, Father Robert A. Meng, Father C. Richard Nangle, Father Jerome F. Schifferli and Father Nicholas Alletto.

Father Schifferli, pastor of St. Joseph Church in Livonia and St. William Church in Conesus, will preside at a celebration of Mass 3 p.m., March 17 at St. Joseph's. A buffet reception will follow at the Avonshire on Polebridge Road. A price of \$10 per person is being charged, to cover both the cost of the meal and a gift. Father Schifferli attended St. Andrew School, and St. Andrew's and St. Bernard's seminaries. He served at St. Michael and St. Mary in Rochester, and at Elmira Correctional Facility. He has been the pastor of the dual parish since 1972.

Father Nangle plans a private celebration.

The associate pastor of Sacred Heart Church in Auburn since 1981 is an Auburn native. He attended Auburn High School, and St. Andrew's and St. Bernard's Seminaries. He has served at St. Francis Xavier, Rochester; Ss. Peter and Paul, Rochester; DeSales High School, Geneva; Holy Family, Auburn; St. Louis, Pittsford; St. Augustine, Rochester; and St. Gregory, Marion.

Father Meng's public celebration will begin with Mass 5:30 p.m., Saturday, March 16. Following Mass a pot-luck, dish-to-pass dinner will be staged in the school hall. Music will be provided by the Dady Brothers.

Father Meng, pastor of Holy Rosary Church since 1968, attended St. Augustine School and St. Andrew's and St. Bernard's seminaries. He has served at St. Jerome, East Rochester; St. Alphonsus, Auburn; St. Patrick, Rochester; St. Alouysius, Auburn; St. Felix, Clifton Springs; St. Anne, Rochester; St. Ann, Hornell; Corpus Christi, Rochester; and Catholic Relief Services, the Congo and Dahomey, Africa.

Father Gaynor will celebrate a Mass of Thanksgiving 11 a.m., March 17 at St. Charles Borromeo in Elmira Heights where he has been pastor since 1969. Following the Mass, a reception in his honor will be held 3-5 p.m., in the church hall.

The Auburn native attended St. Andrew's and St. Bernard's seminaries. He has served at Holy Cross, Rochester; Holy Apostles, Rochester; Ss. Peter and

Paul, Rochester; St. John the Evangelist, Clyde; and St. Francis, Auburn. In addition he served as pastor of St. Catherine's Church in Addison.

Father Foy will celebrate a Mass of Gratitude on his ordination date at St. James Church in Waverly, where he is pastor. A dinner and reception in honor of the anniversary will be held 6 p.m., Thursday, March 14 at the American Legion Home.

Father Foy is a Rochester native. He attended Holy Cross School, and St. Andrew's and St. Bernard's seminaries. He has served at St. Bridget, Rochester; Our Mother of Sorrows, Rochester; St. Michael, Penn Yan; St. Helen, Rochester; St. Jerome, East Rochester; St. Patrick, Owego; Holy Family, Rochester; St. Joseph, Penfield; St. Cecilia, Elmira; and Ss. Peter and Paul, Elmira.

Father Davis will celebrate Mass 3:30 p.m. at St. Patrick's Church in Corning where he is pastor. His parishioners will fete him at a reception following the Mass in the church hall, and at a dinner at 6 p.m.

A Rochester native, Father Davis attended Holy Rosary School, St. Andrew's and St. Bernard's seminaries, and Catholic University of America, Washington, D.C. he holds a masters degree in Library Science. He has served at St. Ambrose Church, as chaplain to the cadets of Nazareth Hall, as procurator-advocate to the diocesan Tribunal; at Blessed Sacrament Church, Church of the Annunciation, St. Philip Neri, and as pastor of Our Lady of Lourdes Church in Elmira, and at St. Mary's Church in Dansville. In addition, Father Davis served many years at St. Bernard's Seminary as librarian, as professor of Literature and as professor of Sacred Eloquence.

Father Collins will celebrate the day with a Mass 11 a.m. March 17, at St. Anthony's Church in Elmira where he is pastor. Later that day his parishioners will fete him at a dinner-dance in the parish center.

Father Collins is a native Rochesterian. He attended Immaculate Conception School and St. Andrew's and St. Bernard's seminaries. In addition he did graduate study at Rutgers University and St. Lawrence University.

He has served at St. Monica, Rochester; Holy Family, Auburn; St. John the Evangelist on Humboldt Street, Rochester; Elmira Reformatory; and as pastor of St. John the Baptist Church in Elmira.

Father Callan, pastor of St. Thomas the Apostle Church, will begin his celebration with Mass, 12:15 p.m., March 17. A reception will be held 1:30-3:30 p.m. in the school hall. The festivities will conclude with cocktails and dinner 6 p.m. and 7 p.m.

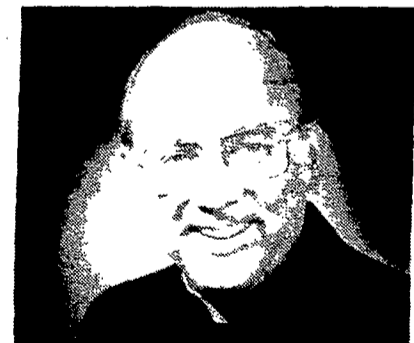
