

State Catholic Divorced Group Issues 1st Edition of Newsletter

The Region II Board of Separated, Divorced, Widowed and Remarried Catholics, which covers New York State, last week published its first state-wide newsletter, "Wellspring."

According to Bob Cobbett, editor of the newsletter, the title is inspired by the Gospel according to St. John's account of the woman at the well. The newsletter's flag was designed by Kristin Malone, whose artworks are



well known in the Rochester community.

"The symbol of the well

has always been meaningful and relevant with the separated and divorced because

of the divorced woman at the well," Cobbett said last week. He described the woman as "the first public minister announcing the coming of Christ."

The first issue contains an essay on the symbolism of the wellspring, an explanation of the work of the Region II board, a listing of diocesan representatives, a notice of an upcoming conference, a meditative piece by Paula Ripple, one of the founders of divorced and separated ministry, and an explanation of the ministry's Beginning Experience Program.

Cobbett, a parishioner of St. Paul's Church in Webster, said he hoped the distribution of "Wellspring" would bring the gifts of the ministry to all in the region. He described those gifts as ranging from "presence as a caring, accepting, listening person, to the local support group, to workshops of healing and growth, to the conferences and the Beginning Experience."

The diocesan representative on the board is Kathy Rampulla of Horseheads.

Father Aschenbrenner spent 10 years as director of novices for the Jesuits in the Maryland province. During this time, in 1972, he wrote the well-known and widely used "Consciousness Examen."

Since 1979 he has combined a busy schedule of talks, retreats and workshops

for religious, priests and laity with pastoral work for the lay faculty and staff at the University of Scranton, Pa., and at St. Joseph's University in Philadelphia.
