Renee Diemoz of Nunda, a senior biology major at St. John Fisher College, has been awarded the Eastern College Athletic Conference Athletic Scholarship Merit Award for 1985.

The college's third all-time leading scorer in soccer and 12th in basketball, Diemoz, who maintained a 3.3 cumulative average, is recognized for her combination of academic and athletic achievement.

The doctor of ministry degree was awarded to **Sister Kathleen A. Milliken, RSM**, at the 1985 commencement exercises of the Colgate Rochester Divinity School/Bexley Hall/Crozer Theological Seminary on May 4.

Sister Kathleen is a part-time staff member at St. Mary's Church in Rochester and of the Chili Counseling Center, a branch of the Catholic Family Center.

Two St. John Fisher College students will study in France during July thanks to Lions International Scholarships distributed by the Basilian Fathers in the U.S. They are **Karen LaMark** of Rochester and **Camilla Wellers** of Webster.

LaMark, a 1984 Fisher graduate in computer science, will attend the International Center of University Encounters. Wellers, a senior majoring in computer science, will study at the Cultural Center for Women.

Kevin Broderick, State small high school player of the year who led Bishop Cunningham of Oswego to the Class D championship last March, will play at Nazareth College next season.

Broderick, a 5-10 point guard who plans to major in business, chose the Golden Flyers over some 20 other colleges.

A 1982 graduate of St. Agnes High School, **Janet Fanale**, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Arthur Fanale of Rochester, has received the Mihail Stolarevsky Award from Chatham College in Pittsburgh.

The award recognizes a junior or senior who has done outstanding work in music, the arts, the humanities or science.

A junior fellowship for individual research at the Folger Shakespeare Library in Washington, D.C. will allow **Douglas Howard**, an assistant professor of English at St.

John Fisher College, to spend June, July and August working in residence at the library.

Howard plans several projects related to drama and politics, specifically in the works of playwrights Philip Massinger and John Ford.

Two long-time medical practitioners were presented with recognition awards at St. Joseph's Hospital 9th Annual Development Council Dinner in Elmira.

Drs. Joseph Montanarella and Gideon Tropp were honored for their service to the community, hospital and the medical profession.

Since 1981, Crociata has been a publicist for musicians and writers as well as developing funds for private secondary schools and colleges.
