

New company offers scholarship searches

Recognizing the financial needs of high school and college students who desire to pursue higher educations, a new company has formed, aimed at helping eligible students find sources of financial aid.

Scholarships Unlimited, a computerized research and matching service with headquarters at 38 Meadowlark Drive, Penfield, has computerized listings of more than \$3 billion in financial aid programs — scholarships, grants, awards and part-time jobs. The company can provide students with listings of financial aid sources for which they are qualified based upon the information submitted by the students.

According to company President Richard M. Lembo, more than \$100 million in

financial aid goes unused each year because students and their parents simply don't know that these sources exist. Quoting from a book by Kenneth and Irene Kohl, entitled "Financing College Education," he said: "Parents and students often depend on the schools to help them find scholarship funds. The fact is that the teachers, guidance counselors and financial aid officers lack both the time and the comprehensive knowledge that would enable them to provide a complete listing of sources."

Lembo said he believes "It's a shame that students must either forego the quality education they so richly deserve or are forced to attend a college not of their choosing simply because of the prohibitive cost of
