cooperation was encouraged at the regional level. In the words of Monsignor Donald Mulcahy, executive secretary of the committee: "Once we've got that, we can have the pastoral council."

A constitution had also to be written and approved by members of the formation committee, diocesan consultative groups — the Priests' Council, Sisters' Council, and regional assemblies — and Bishop Hogan. Final approval was gained in February, 1975.

In closing his morning prayer Saturday at the Leadership Conference, Bishop Clark praised the DPC's accomplishments, but also urged patience. Contrasting the billions of seconds when life began in the universe — as proposed by the "big bang" theory — with the almost inconceivable billions of years during which the universe has existed, he compared both extremes to the 10 years the DPC has existed. "I hope that such a contextualization helps us to relax a bit about

our endeavors, because you and I aren't going to get it done that fast, and what we do probably is not going to last all that long," he said. "But what Paul reminds us of (in the reading from Philippians 2:1-4) should be the life-giving and sustaining and animating force of it all. That is that somehow in the midst of this colossal mystery of life, God so loved us poor creatures ... that he brought together all time and space and meaning, all past and future, and made it present in the risen life of Christ."
