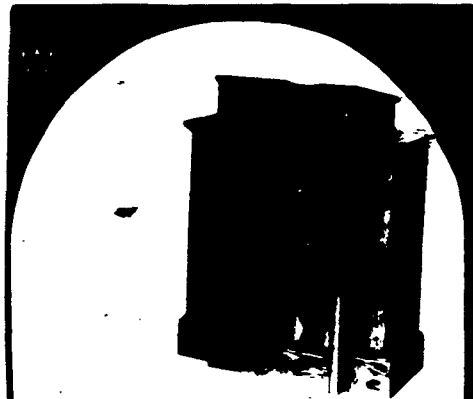
Women's Aglow Fellowship
