The First Annual Handicapped Progress Award was presented to **Sister Seraphine Herbst**, principal of the School of the Holy Childhood, at the Annual Meeting of the Easter Seal Society of Monroe County. Sister Seraphine has served as director of the school since 1962. The school was one of the first to provide classes for learning disabled and mentally handicapped children.

Rod Swartwood, an oxygen technician at Rochester General Hospital, and **Betty Morton**, Program Director for TRIADD, were also recognized for their service. **Marcia Taillie** and **Elizabeth Kendall**, twenty-year Easter Seal volunteers, were given volunteer recognition awards.

Fundraising administrator **Mary G. Philippone**, of 142 Pennwood Dr., Penfield, and certified public accountant **Michael Prugel**, of 234 Oriole St., Rochester, have been elected to the board of directors of Natural Family Planning Education of Rochester, New York, Inc.

Philippone, a 1984 Nazareth alumnus, manages several special fundraising programs as assistant director of development at Nazareth College. Prugel is employed at Cortland L. Brovitz & Co. P.C. He graduated from the University of Buffalo in 1978 and earned his CPA certification in 1980.

Father William Heffron, ss.cc. was inaugurated into a second term as Provincial Superior of the U.S.A. East Coast Province of the Sacred Hearts Community on Jan. 13. Father Heffron was re-elected by priests and brothers of the Province which includes this country east of the Rocky Mountains, Japan, India, and the Bahamas.

Before he became Provincial in January 1983, Father Heffron was a missionary in Japan, served as Master of Novices and Provincial Director of Formation for new members, and was a pastor of SS Peter and Paul Church, Rochester.

Four years ago, **Sister Claudé Loeb**, R.S.M., helped black residents from Vredenburgh, Alabama establish voting rights in their town. Loeb originally gathered a small group of women from the town for Bible study. A year later, they began to discuss the community's problems. These women began attending council meetings and educating the town's other black residents about ways to participate in town politics. In 1984, for the first time, blacks ran and won a majority of seats on the five member town council.

Loeb also worked with Vredenburgh's mayor, Frank Stewart, to establish a health clinic in the town. She got funds from the Alabama Lutheran Council and the

Edmundite Missions to remodel the town's abandoned schoolhouse into a clinic. Before the clinic was opened last November, Vredenburgh residents never had health care facilities.

Loeb, formerly a nurse from Rochester, now works with the Selma-based Edmundite (Society of St. Edmund) Missions.

Five high school seniors have been named winners in the sixth annual Wimmer Scholarship program at St. Vincent College. One of the five awarded the 10,000 scholarship was Cardinal Mooney High School student **Paul D. Toth** of 39 Stonehill Drive, Rochester, N.Y. Toth has already been accepted for admission to St. Vincent College in the fall of 1986.

Gaynelle Wethers was this year's recipient of the Martin Luther King Jr. Community Service award, presented by the Black Church Studies Program and the Black Student Caucus of Colgate Rochester Divinity School/Bexley Hall/Crozer Theological Seminary.

Wethers, the principal of St. Monica's School, was honored for her outstanding dedication and commitment to the education and development of youth in the greater Rochester community.

Students and staff at Corpus Christi School also presented Wethers with a token of their esteem — a poster signed by everyone at the school. "Thank you for helping us to be part of the dream," the poster read.
