gurated into a second term as Provincial Superior of the U.S.A. East Coast Province of the Sacred Hearts Community on Jan. 13. Father Heffron was re-elected by priests and brothers of the Province which includes this country east of the Rocky Mountains, Japan, India, and the Bahamas.

Edmundite Missions to remodes the town's abandoned schoolhouse into a vinic. Before the clinic was opened last November, Vredenburgh residents never had health care facilities.




