"I thought Rocky IV was great. It made me proud of my country. Rocky, the underdog, whipped the Russian. It reminded me how great we are and how we play to win."



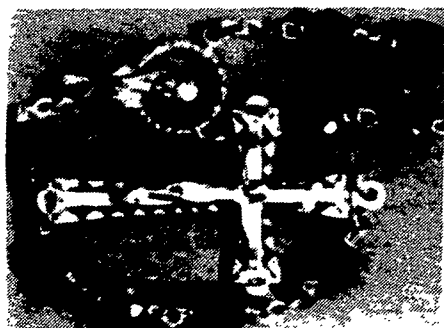
McQuaid Senior Honored

program. However, he also thinks the teacher-in-space idea was too commercialized, and not enough stress was placed on the actual rigors Mrs. McAuliffe would face. If more civilians apply for a shuttle mission, he says NASA should go ahead with the program, but not until the cause of the accident at Cape Canaveral has been determined.

Not all of Ady's time is spent pondering world affairs, however. He has adapted to American lifestyles very quickly. He admits he was taken by surprise by Americans' obsession with pizza. "I didn't expect to find so much of it here!" he exclaims.

The only thing Ady finds hard to get used to is the distances we Americans have to travel to get from one point to another. "You really can't go anywhere without a car," he observes.

As might be expected Ady writes home often. He keeps a diary of everything that happens to him. Then he transfers it all into letters bound for his parents and his two younger sisters back in Switzerland. He says that his family is less concerned with America than with his health - "especially my mother!"

So far, Ady is enjoying his stay in America, and plans to learn more about our country before he leaves in June. He would very much like to return to the U.S. some day, and is even hoping to bring his parents along. In fact, he would like to return as soon as next winter so he can visit his friends at Notre Dame.

We thank Ady for enriching our school, and we hope that we can help him further understand our culture.
