New Project For Local Missioner

A four-year high school for girls in northeastern Tanzania is the project an Elmira native, **Father Damian Milliken, O.S.B.**, has undertaken. A missionary in East Africa for the past 26 years, Father Milliken, brother of **Sister Kathleen Milliken, R.S.M.**, visited Rochester and Elmira in January. He reiterated the importance of education for the people of Africa, so that they can become self-sufficient.

"Every Tanzanian child (about one million of them) has the opportunity to finish seventh grade," Father Milliken said. "Of this number, 25,000 go on to high school, and only one out of four is a girl. So you can understand our desire to provide more education for women in Tanzania."

A member of the Benedictine Missionaries

of St. Paul's Abbey in Newton, New Jersey, Father Milliken teaches in Magamba Secondary School for boys, serves as pastor in the district of Lushoto, and is chaplain to a group of African Sisters who conduct Mazinde Juu High in Lushoto, a two-year domestic science school for girls.

Along with Sister Antonetta Lyaya, superior of the community, Father Milliken hopes to expand Mazinde Juu to a four-year format by January, 1987.

But first he needs more qualified instructors — both religious and lay — to serve for two or three years, teaching basic high school subjects.

Since the African Sisters have the equivalent of a junior college education, they are not yet qualified to teach in a four-year high school. Plans are underway to enable

them to complete their college degrees.

During recent years, Father Milliken has drawn support from his home parish, St. Patrick's, Elmira, as well as St. Mary's, Rochester and the Newman Oratory in Brockport. During his visit, he thanked all who have sent shipments of clothing and supplies as well as prayers and donations.

For the first time in 17 years, **Holy Ghost School's** seventh- and eighth-grade basketball team not only qualified, but also won the annual Bishop Kearney Basketball Tournament held last month in Auburn.

Defeating Corning South and St. Pius X in preliminary games, 47-44 and 56-47 respectively, Holy Ghost took on Our Lady of Lourdes, Elmira in the finals and defeated them 68-54.

Holy Ghost's leading scorers for the tournament were **Jeff Mitchell, Dom Guerrieri, Doug Cook and Scott Toates**. Other team members included: **Brent Bashaw, Jamie Brunette, Scott Ebert, John Sharpe, Carl McMahon and Tim Quinn**.

The team was led by coach **Larry Mitchell** and assistant coach **Neil Davis**.

A team of fifth- and sixth-graders from **St. Theodore's School** in Gates placed third in the Monroe County Library Bowl Competition.

Participants were asked questions about 70 books they were required to read in the past several months.

After beating out teams from Holy Ghost and public schools #16 and #37 in one of 12 regional competitions, St. Theodore's team traveled to the finals at Rundel Public Library March 22.

The diocesan Lakes Chapter of the Knights of Columbus welcomed State Deputy of the New York State Council, **Thomas C. Hovanick**, and **Bishop Matthew H. Clark** to the Bishop's Bourse Dinner. More than 320 guests attended the dinner last month at the Thruway Marriott.
