## Sister Christina Welch, SSJ, at 77; area elementary, high school teacher

A Mass of Christian Burial for Sister Christina Welch of the Sisters of St. Joseph was celebrated in the Motherhouse Chapel on Monday evening, April 28. Sister Christina died in the St. Joseph Convent Infirmary on Saturday, April 26, 1986. She was 77.

The principal celebrant for the Mass was Father Louis Vasile, who was assisted by Fathers

Peter Bayer, John O'Connor and Paul Cuddy.

Sister Christina was a native of Webster and entered the Sisters of St. Joseph from Holy Trinity Parish, Webster, in 1927. A graduate of Webster High School, Sister Christina earned her bachelor's degree from Nazareth College and her master's degree from St. Bonaventure University. She participated in various workshops in her major field of English at Georgetown University, Vassar College and the University of Rochester. Sister Christina taught at Nazareth Academy for 28 years and at St. Agnes High School for eight years. In addition, she was director of public relations at St. Agnes from 1978 to 1981.

Besides teaching in the two high schools, Sister Christina also taught for a short time at St. Bridget's, Rochester, and St. Paul's, Oswego.

Sister Christina retired to St. Joseph Convent Infirmary in 1983. She is survived by two sisters, Connie Welch and Margaret Dennie of Macedon; brothers and sisters-in-law, Norbert and Hazel Welch of Webster, Raymond and Florence Welch of Penfield, Father Leo Welch, SJ of the Philippines, and Margaret and Jeanne Welch of Webster.

Burial was Tuesday morning, April 28, in the Sisters' section of Holy Sepulchre Cemetery.

## Monsignor Robert B. Ervin, 61; served as pastor in New Jersey

Monsignor Robert B. Ervin, 61, died in St. Joseph's Hospital, Elmira, on Saturday, April 19, 1986. An Elmira native and a graduate of both St. Patrick's School and Catholic High School, Monsignor Ervin served as a priest of the Diocese of Camden, New Jersey, for 35 years. He had been pastor of St. Casimer's Parish in Woodbine, N.J. He received the pastorate in the fall of 1985 as a result of his continuing struggle with cancer.

Monsignor Ervin was ordained on March

10, 1951, and was made a Prelate of Honor (monsignor) by Pope John Paul II on May 22, 1983.

Bishop James L. Schad, auxiliary bishop of Camden, was the principal concelebrant of the Mass of Christian Burial in St. Patrick's Church, Elmira, on Tuesday, April 22. Monsignor Ervin was buried in St. Peter and Paul Cemetery in Elmira.

Monsignor Ervin is survived by his mother, Catherine Ervin; his brother, Walter; and sisters-in-law, Polly and Helen.

## Irondequoit woman dies, 89

A former Irondequoit resident, Marie B. Klem died at Latta Road Nursing Home on Tuesday, Jan. 28. The wife of the late Paul R. Klem, she was 89.
