In 1983, Father Osborne was among the first friars to serve in a newly formed mission in East Africa. He is now responsible for governing the fledgling mission territory served by 60 friars. He is now traveling throughout Tanzania, Zambia, Malawi and Uganda to learn more about the needs of the Church in those areas.
