After 48 years at Nazareth Academy, during which time she taught every business subject in the curriculum, Sister Ruth Magin retired June 30.

"Sister Ruth has prepared literally thousands of women who have been successful in business and careers," said Sister Elaine Englert, Nazareth's principal and a former student of Sister Ruth's. "She was totally involved with students, from taking us on picnics to coming to all our dances, to walking with us to the lake. She has always given without counting the cost."

Sister Ruth, who was known as Sister John Mary before 1972, began teaching business students in 1938.

For the past 25 years, Sister Ruth has organized the annual Business Careers Day at the academy, inviting successful graduates to share their stories with the school's business students. "You can't go into many businesses in Rochester without meeting a Nazareth graduate," Sister Ruth is fond of saying.
