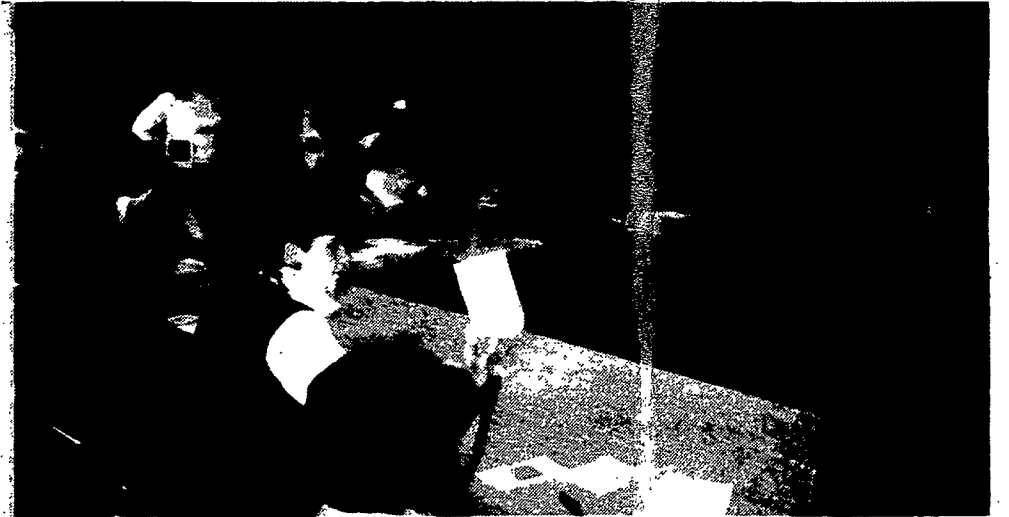
During her years at Mercy, Fuller earned a grade point average of 91 while participating in a number of extracurricular activities.
