Child was devoted and tender."

A colonel "baptized" the bomber, naming it Enola Gay after his mother, and chose "Dimples" as the plane's secret radio call sign. "The bombing mission would be a kind of flying smile," Bellavia read.

As several actors portrayed Japanese people engaged in ordinary household activities, Bellavia recalled the view from the bomber.

"The city was full of sun. The fliers could see the green grass in the gardens. No fighters rose up to meet them. There was no flak. No

one in the city bothered to take cover."

The actors then fell to the floor, one by one, as the narrator described the bomb's impact and its aftermath. "The fireball was 18,000 feet across. The temperature at the center of the fireball was 100 million degrees. The people who were at the center became nothing. The whole city was blown to bits and the ruins caught fire instantly everywhere, burning briskly. Seventy-thousand people were killed right away or died within a few hours.

"It took a little while for the rest of Japan to find out what had happened to Hiroshima," Merton wrote. "Papers were forbidden to publish any news of the new bomb ... Then the military governor of the prefecture of Hiroshi-

ma issued a proclamation full of martial spirit.

"To all of the people without hands, without feet, with their faces falling off, with their intestines hanging out, with their whole bodies full of radiation: we must not rest a single day in our war effort! We must bear in mind that the road to revenge is the annihilation of the stubborn enemy."

Meanwhile, Merton observed, "those who did not die right away suffered great pain. Few of them were soldiers. The men in the plane perceived that the raid had been successful, but they thought of the people in the city and they were not perfectly happy. Some felt they had done wrong. But in any case, they had obeyed orders. It was war."

On August 9, while Hiroshima was still burning, another bomb was dropped on Nagasaki.

Merton ends his prose poem with a question that still has not been answered. "Since that summer, many other bombs have been 'found.' What is going to happen?"

"People seem to be fatigued by the whole question," he concluded.
