

Camp Stella Maris campaign exceeds the \$100,000 mark

A three-year fund-raising campaign launched by Camp Stella Maris in June recently passed the \$100,000 mark.

According to Raymond Tette, executive director of the camp, \$102,700 has been pledged to the camp's capital development program.

Tette said the camp is seeking \$400,000 for various construction and renovation projects.

This drive, the first fund-raising campaign of its kind in camp history, is being chaired by Brian Dwyer, vice president and manager of Chase Lincoln Bank's Pittsford Financial Service Group.

Camp Stella Maris, located some 30 miles south of Rochester on the eastern shore of Conesus Lake, is celebrating 60 years of resident camping this summer.

The camp's fund-raising effort received a major boost from Gertrude Chanler of Geneseo. Chanler, a longtime camp supporter, pledged \$25,000 during a recent visit to

the camp. According to Tette, the camp is wrapping up its most successful summer season in its history, with a capacity number of seven to 15 year olds attending camp each week during the past two months.

Under the guidance of Tette, the number of resident campers has nearly doubled in 10 years, going from 730 in 1975 to more than 1,400 this year.

In 1977, Tette initiated a program that has helped send more than 1,100 financially deprived children to Camp Stella Maris.

"Through contributions to our campership fund, some 130 children and young adults, who would otherwise not be able to attend, come to camp each summer," Tette said.

Strictly a children's summer camp during its early years, Camp Stella Maris now conducts programs for senior citizens, families, schools, churches and business groups throughout the year.

CFC asks parishes to sponsor refugees

Parish councils throughout the diocese are asked to remember the plight of Amerasian refugees. Sponsors are desperately needed to make a 45-90 day commitment of time and interest to ensure a future for "our war children."

Because they are half American, these children have no future in Vietnam. But they are unable to enter the U.S. without sponsors. "In justice, they really are our kids and this is where they belong," said Jim Delaney, local representative of the U.S. Catholic Conference (USCC) Refugee Resettlement Office.

Resettlement sponsorship involves: meeting refugees at the airport; transporting them to temporary or permanent housing; collecting donations of furniture, bedding, clothing and kitchen supplies; transporting refugees to medical and social service appointments; enrolling them in appropriate schools and programs; and guiding them toward self-sufficiency and employment.

Catholic Family Center, in cooperation with the U.S. Catholic Conference, will provide \$250 to cover the expenses of refugees until social service funding has been arranged.

Resettlement is not an open-ended commitment. It does not entail foster-care, adoption or any legal or financial obligation.
