

### Festival of Music features chorus, hand-bell choir

Singing voices and ringing bells echoed throughout St. Ann's Home/The Heritage on Tuesday, September 30, as the St. Ann's chorus and very own hand-bell choir presented its first-ever Festival of Music before a standing-room-only crowd.

According to Ann C. Julien, who has been director of community relations at St. Ann's for the past three and a half years, the choir has been practicing weekly for more than a year.

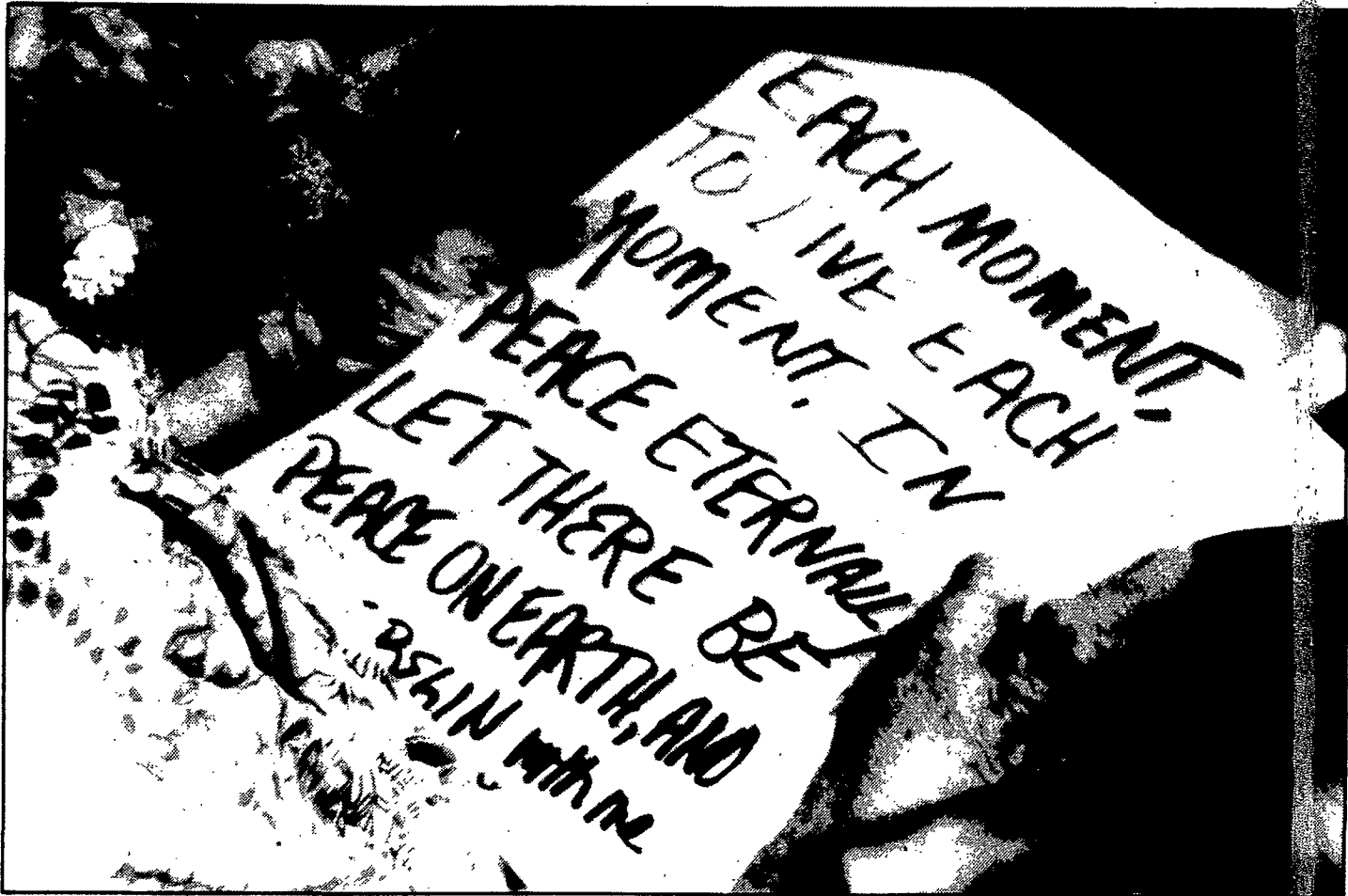
Under the direction of recreation therapist June Weltzer, the choir presented its first performance during an Easter Vigil Mass this year. The choir has also received the expert assistance of Nancy Krupenet of the Hochstein School of Music.

"They (the Hochstein School) have been very supportive," Julien said. "We looked to them for advice for the hand-bell choir, and they've been helping us along the way ever since."

Julien said the choir has two octave of bells which vary in size, and each bell represents a different note.

Future plans for the choir include a performance at the Rochester Methodist Home in November as well as a musical program for Bishop Matthew H. Clark in December.

The St. Ann's Chorus is planning to entertain friends and relatives at the home at Christmas.
