Sr. Grace Ferrazzano, taught at Watkins Glen

Sister Grace Ferrazzano, 62, a former teacher at Our Lady of the Lake Parish in Watkins Glen, died at Wayne General Hospital in Wayne, N.J., on Sunday, October 12, 1986.

A Mass of Christian Burial was concelebrated by more than 25 priests in the St. Lucy Filippini Chapel at Villa Walsh on October 15.

Born October 15, 1923, Sister Grace entered the Institute of the Religious Teachers Filippini in 1936. She received her habit in 1940, and made her final oblation in 1943.

A religious teacher Filippini for 46 years, Sister Grace was an elementary school teacher, principal and most recently director of religious education in Cranford, N.J. Sister Grace lived in the Holy Family Convent in Nutley, N.J.

In addition to teaching in Watkins Glen, Sister Grace taught at numerous New Jersey locations including St. Michael's School in Cranford, St. Mary of Mt. Virgin in New Brunswick, St. Anthony in Belleville, St. Joseph in East Orange and St. Bartholomew in Scotch Plains.

Sister Grace also taught in Pennsylvania, Rhode Island and Ohio.

Sister Grace is survived by her sisters, Sister Beatrice Ferrazzano, Scotch Plains, N.J.; Agnes Ferrazzano, Paterson, N.J.; Marie Mar-mo, N.J.; Anna Grochowski, Clifton, N.J.; Celeste Miele, Paterson, N.J.; brothers Dominic Ferrazzano Beach Haven, N.J.; and John Ferrazzano, Conygham, Pennsylvania; and many nieces and nephews.

Sister Laurene Marie Kochert, SSJ, at 84

A Mass of Christian Burial for Sister Laurene Marie Kochert, SSJ, was celebrated in the Sister of Saint Joseph Motherhouse Chapel on Wednesday evening, October 22. Sister Laurene Marie died October 20, 1986 in the St. Joseph Convent Infirmary. She was 84 years of age.

The principal celebrant of the Mass was Father Joseph Jankowiak, who has been a student of Sister Laurene Marie's at Aquinas Institute. Father Thomas Miller, CSB, and Father Joseph Travato, CSB, were also present.

Sister Laurene Marie was a native of Rochester and graduated from Nazareth Academy in 1921. She entered the Sisters of St. Joseph from St. Francis Xavier Parish in Rochester in 1923. She later earned a New York State lifetime teaching certificate from Nazareth Normal School, a baccalaureate degree from St. Bonaventure University and a master's degree from the Catholic University of America, Washington, D.C.

Sister Laurene Marie taught for 46 years. Her first assignments included teaching posi-

tions at Nazareth Hall for one year, and St. Paul's Academy in Oswego for eight years. In 1934 she came to Aquinas, where she taught German and Latin for a period of 22 years. She moved on to St. Agnes High School in 1956, where she taught until 1971.

Retiring from teaching in 1971 because of failing health, Sister Laurene Marie moved to St. Joseph Convent Infirmary.

During her retirement, Sister Laurene Marie retained her interest in school-related happenings. Her knowledge of local history and appreciation of music delighted all those around her. She has a great sensitivity and love for animals as well as all the beauties of nature.

Sister Laurene Marie is survived by a sister, Mrs. Anne Murphy of Huntington Beach, Calif., brother and sister-in-law, Raymond and Mary Kochert of Webster; nieces, nephews, and grandnieces and grandnephews.
