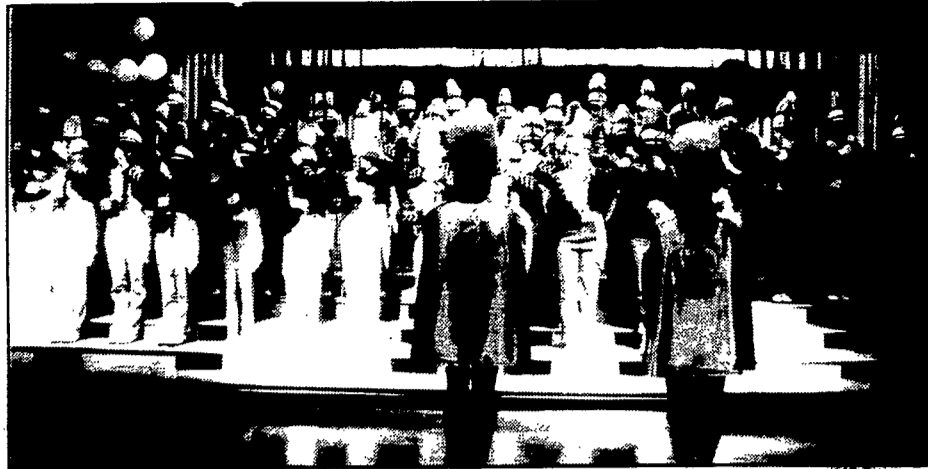


# Marching Kings highlight Holy Childhood anniversary
