Obituary

Varden Studios partner, Paul McGuire, at 80

Paul A. McGuire, a pioneer in the development of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish, Brighton, and a leader of diocesan joint high school and college fund drives, died on November 20, 1986, at the age of 80.

Mr. McGuire was born in Chicago of very poor parents and began working early in life as a photo salesman. Through the support of a pastor in Minneapolis, he began specializing in comprehensive photographic coverage of marriages. In the late 1920s, he formed a partnership with Irving A. Stern in Sioux City, Iowa. The partners moved to Rochester in the early 30s, and established Varden

Mr. McGuire was the quasi-official diocesan photographer for many years, photographing events from high school graduations to the consecration installation of bishops. The official photos of the bishops of Rochester from 1937-1978, which can be found in almost every parish of the diocese, were prepared under Mr. McGuire's direc-
