Open house scheduled at St. John the Evangelist

St. John the Evangelist, Rochester — The Catholic elementary school, which is located at 2376 Ridge Road West in Greece, will be hosting an open house for families interested in pre-school and kindergarten classes for 1987-88.

Classrooms will be open Saturday, February 28, from 9:30 a.m. to 11 a.m. Sister Marilyn Reeves, principal, as well as kindergarten and pre-school teachers and parents of students presently enrolled at St. John's will be on hand to answer questions.

The pre-school program, now in its eighth year, is a program for three and four year olds. In preparation for kindergarten, the school uses COPE (Cognitively Oriented Pre-kindergarten Experience) curriculum.

The curriculum includes large-group activities in religion, physical education, music and art. Computer instruction is used to supplement the program.

The curriculum in the kindergarten covers the areas of religion, reading readiness, mathematics, social studies, science and other disciplines.

Pre-school children must be three or four years of age on or before December 1 of this year. Kindergarten students must be five years of age on or before December 1.

Registration for pre-school, kindergarten and grades one through eight will be taken in the school hall on Monday evening, March 2, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m., and Tuesday, March 3, through Friday, March 6, from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. in the school library, for registered members of St. John's parish.

Registration for members of Holy Name, St. Mark's, and St. Leo's parishes will be taken on Monday, March 9, through Thursday, March

12, from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. in the office.

Children of families not in these parishes may register March 16 through March 20 from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. in the school office.

Parents should bring birth certificates and baptismal records when they register. The baptismal record is not necessary if the child was baptized at St. John's Church. A registration fee of \$20 is required.
