"For awhile, they weren't stressing it as much as they used to, especially when the school was having financial problems," Arioli said. "The three or four thousand dollars raised would help other sports (teams) that weren't making any money; I'm sure every little bit helped. But Father Martin changed that. He said, 'We (the school) need the money, but there are other people (working in the missions) who need it more than we do. And I agree with that 100 percent'."

At the breakfast for boxers and parents last Sunday, March 15, it was announced that \$3,000 dollars was raised to help the work of the missions.

For Arioli, it was yet another shot in the arm for the intramural boxing program at AQ — a goal he has fought for all along.

"Once you start working with the kids and the different personalities, you see how kids really open up to you," he commented. "The years between 14 and 18 are the hardest. You need somebody (outside of the family), whether it is a coach or whoever. Kevin and I really enjoy it."
