## Bishop Clark to celebrate annual Chrism Mass

Once again, the annual diocesan Chrism Mass will continue the ancient tradition of blessing the oils used in sacramental celebrations throughout the coming year. Bishop Matthew H. Clark will preside at the event this Holy Week, on Tuesday, April 14, at 7:30 p.m. at Sacred Heart Cathedral.

Bishops Dennis W. Hickey and Joseph L. Hogan will join the priests of the diocese in this celebration. Churches from the Southern Tier will provide the combined choir for the event, while regional coordinators, their associates, diocesan division directors and members of the bishop's ministries will serve

as Eucharistic ministers and participate in the processions.

Other ministers will represent their respective parishes: Sacred Heart Cathedral, St. Catherine's Church in Mendon, St. Joseph's Church in Rush and Immaculate Conception Church in Rochester.

The Chrism Mass will be celebrated in Spanish and English, and signed for the hearing-impaired. A public reception, sponsored by the Catholic Women's Guild of Rochester, will follow in the Sacred Heart Cathedral School Hall. All are invited to attend.

## Obituary

### Father Turner, 80, pastor emeritus in Phelps

Father Francis H. Turner, pastor emeritus of St. Francis Church, Phelps, died Friday, April 3, 1987, at the Villa Maria Nursing Center in Miami, Fla. He was 80.

After completing his training for the priesthood at St. Andrew's and St. Bernard's seminaries, Father Turner was ordained by Bishop Emmett J. Walsh at St. Patrick's Cathedral, Rochester, on June 10, 1933.

Father Turner served as assistant pastor of several parishes, prior to his appointment as pastor of St. Bernard's, Scipio Center. He sub-

sequently served as pastor of St. Catherine's, Addison; St. Felix, Clifton Springs; St. Mary of the Lake, Watkins Glen; and St. Francis, Phelps, where he continued until ill health forced him to retire in 1976.

Father Turner is survived by one brother, John R. Turner of Miami Beach, Fla., and by several cousins. Mass of Christ the High Priest was celebrated at Sacred Heart Cathedral, Rochester, on Monday evening, April 6, with Mass of Christian Burial on Tuesday morning, April 7. Interment was in Holy Sepulchre Cemetery.

think about what happens when there is no priest in a parish," Bishop Clark remarked at a Diocesan Pastoral Council meeting last month.

What will happen in many parishes are communion services — a form of liturgy that is likely to become increasingly familiar to habitués of daily Mass.

"Communion services are no longer going to be the rarest of exceptions," said Father Schwartz. "It faces you with the reality that there are going to be times when there won't be a morning Eucharist, something we've always taken for granted."

Parishioners in rural areas of the diocese

have already learned not to take daily Mass for granted, according to Father McCaffrey, who is pastor at St. John the Evangelist in Newark Valley and St. Francis in Catatonk.

"People here are accustomed to having no Mass when the priest goes away," he said. "Out in the country, people kind of smile at parishes in the city where that's a big deal. We've been living with it for years."

In case of emergencies or funerals during the convocation, priests who serve as diocesan regional coordinators are organizing retired and religious-order priests to cover parishes and hospitals.

"I just hope there isn't a funeral," Father McCaffrey said. "If someone died — bishop's conference or no bishop's conference — it would be very difficult to explain why the pastor wasn't here."
