It's an ironic arrangement. In 1956, after St. Jerome's new school building was completed, St. Joseph's parish rented several rooms next door in St. Jerome's empty recreation center to inaugurate its own parish school. During the same year, the East Rochester Public Schools also rented four vacant classrooms from St. Jerome's to relieve overcrowding in the second grade.

St. Jerome's Parish will continue to offer subsidies to parents of students who attend St. Joseph's as well as Seton Junior High. "St. Jerome's still has a commitment to Seton Junior High, and we will continue that commitment," Lustyk said.

Father Masciangelo hopes that once he and parishioners "catch our breath," they can put the school building and parish resources toward improving the religious education program.

Ted Marino is counting on an excellent religious education program for his son. He

has worked hard to save St. Jerome's and he has been pleased by the education his son has received there. But Marino has opted to send his child to a neighborhood public school next year, rather than to another Catholic school.

"(St. Jerome's) was a warm, loving environment — a very positive environment for him," Marino said. "But we chose a small, tight-knit community where our child could walk to school, and we moved here for that purpose."

In the remaining days before the school closes, Lustyk hopes to perpetuate St. Jerome's character and to avoid giving in to a communal sense of loss.

On Sunday, June 14, all present and former students; parents, teachers, pastors, principals and benefactors are invited to a "celebration of new beginnings"

The celebration will begin with a liturgy at 2 p.m. in the church, followed by a reception and open house. "We want people to know that yes, the closing is a sad thing, but we're trying to remain upbeat about it," Lustyk said.
