As athletic director and baseball coach, he also hopes other established sports programs will be able to maintain competitiveness, especially with the projected decline in enrollment.

"(Starting lacrosse) may hurt track more than anything else ... because of the (declining) numbers," Jordan said.

Father Nochelski conceded that lacrosse may take away from other sports at first, but in the long run will serve as sort of a "recruiting tool" for McQuaid.

Another potential problem is the shortage of field space. McQuaid is already in the process of working on its athletic fields, according to the McQuaid principal. The first stage of improvements includes the installation of an eight-lane, all weather surface and extensive work on the gridiron.

"They're going to have to go off-campus for both practices and games," said Father Nochelski about locations where the lacrosse team will compete in its inaugural season.

He added that cooperation among coaches at McQuaid will be vital while "reorganization of the playing surfaces" is taking place.

"We've spoken to a lot of people involved, and they realize that the playing fields are in (dire) need of being redone; they're willing to put up with that," Father Nochelski said. "They know that vast improvements will be made. It's worth the effort."

Bishop Kearney lacrosse Coach Jim Burns enthusiastically welcomes McQuaid's decision to join the lacrosse ranks, regardless of the level at which the school will compete or where it will play.

"I think it's great; you have to start out somewhere," said Burns, whose team finished at 6-9 this season. "Overall, I think it's great to see another city school start up a lacrosse program. One way or another, we'll be glad to play them ... at any level."

The Fighting King Coach did express some reservations about relying on outgoing seniors to establish the program, though.

"It's OK to start at the varsity ... but they won't be fed by the JV like our program," Burns said. "I'm not too familiar with the 'B team' (concept)."

The lax coach illustrated his point by adding that, although Kearney's varsity had a sub .500 season, the JV squad was 12-3. "I'll have about 15 up from that team," Burns said confidently.

At least for now, McQuaid will not have that luxury.
