### Taking fishing to heart

Coors Company has announced a Lake Ontario Fishing Derby to benefit the American Heart Association, Genesee Valley Chapter. All proceeds will remain in the Rochester area to support heart research, public and professional education programs and community service projects.

The two-part event will consist of a spring derby from June 26-28 and a fall derby, scheduled for September 4-7, both in the western basin of Lake Ontario.

More than \$15,000 in cash and prizes will be awarded, including a season grand prize of \$3,000 for the largest trout or salmon caught between June 26 and September 7, 1987. Fishermen must be entered in both derbies in order to qualify for the season grand prize.

The registration fee for each derby is \$20, or \$30 for both the spring and fall derbies.

A special 12-and-under season derby is also scheduled. There is no entry fee, but children must be registered to qualify for the prize drawing.

Entrants may register at any of the three weigh stations: Hatch and Elam, Two Bridges, Braddocks Bay, Greece; and Jack Daniels, Irondequoit; or by calling Lois Franklin at the American Heart Association at (716) 461-5590.

### New mermen coach



John Buckholtz, a highly successful swim coach at Rochester Institute of Technology for 18 years, was recently named head men's swim coach at Nazareth College.

Buckholtz joins the Nazareth athletic staff after compiling a record of 141-48 at RIT, where he started the program in 1968 and coached through the 1983-84 season. He enjoyed his best year in 1970-71, when the Tiger mermen finished 17-0.

At RIT, he coached 37 All-Americans, including Barry Zacharias, who won an NCAA Division III title in the 400-yard individual medley in 1982.

In taking over the Golden Flyers' mens swim program, Buckholtz has his work cut out for him. The program temporarily disbanded last season due to a lack of interest. Nazareth, however, has experienced moderate success in the past, having accrued a record of 55-49-1 in nine seasons while producing five All-Americans.

Buckholtz replaces Peter Saxe, who compiled a 10-12 record in two seasons at Nazareth. In addition to coaching the Golden Flyers, Buckholtz will continue to teach physical education courses at RIT.
