

Keuka College program to focus on better liturgical celebrations

Celebrating Liturgy, an institute for those involved in preparing and celebrating liturgy, will take place at Keuka College on August 21 and 22.

Father John Allyn McElroy, SM, assistant professor of liturgy at the University of Notre Dame, will be the presenter. During the two-day conference, Father McElroy will make three presentations entitled "Come, Let Us Worship: The Theology of Celebration," "Seasons of Grace: The Liturgical Year," and "Where Two or Three are Gathered: The Ministry of Planning."

In addition to Father McElroy's presentations, several workshops and small group discussions have been scheduled. The workshops will deal with roles and relationships among parish staff members; the skills necessary for effective leadership of liturgy committees; the scope and responsibility of liturgy committee members; and how the ministries of art and environment, lector, eucharistic minister, music, usher and server all play important roles in creating an atmosphere in which the assembly can pray and grow in faith.

The institute will begin at 6:30 p.m. on Friday, and will conclude Saturday afternoon at 3:30 p.m.
