Father Raymond W. Wuest, 75; emeritus pastor of Auburn parish



Following a long illness, Father Raymond M. Wuest, pastor emeritus of St. Alphonsus Church, Auburn, died Monday, July 20, 1986, at St. Ann's Home.

Father Wuest, born in Rochester October 27, 1911, to Andrew and Martha Wuest, was ordained to the priesthood at St. Patrick's Cathedral by Cardinal Edward Mooney on

June 4, 1937, after having been graduated from St. Andrew's and St. Bernard's seminaries. Father Wuest served as assistant pastor in several Rochester parishes until 1960, when he was appointed pastor of St. Bernard's in Scipio Center, St. Hilary's in Genoa and St. Isaac Jogues in Fleming. He was subsequently named pastor of St. Mary's, Dansville, in 1964 and St. Alphonsus, Auburn, in 1969. Ill health forced Father Wuest's retirement in 1973 and until recent months, he had resided at St. Mary's Parish, Elmira.

Despite a serious heart condition, Father

Wuest remained remarkably active in retirement and generously assisted several Elmira-area parishes insofar as his health allowed. His faithful acceptance of his protracted infirmity was an inspiration to his priest friends and to all those to whom he ministered.

He is survived by three sisters — Sister Mary Wuest, SSJ; Sister Imelda Wuest, SSJ; and Mrs. Martha Hunt — brother Andrew; and sister-in-law Florence; and several nieces and nephews.

Sister Dolorita Ferguson, SSJ, 89; diocesan teacher for 57 years

A Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated Wednesday, July 8, for Sister Dolorita Ferguson of the Sisters of St. Joseph. Sister Ferguson died in Park Ridge Hospital on Saturday, July 4, 1987, at the age of 89.

Celebrants for the SSJ motherhouse liturgy were Father John Maloney and Monsignor William Shannon, as well as Fathers Foster Rogers, Bernard Carges, Louis Hohmann and Thomas Rosica, CSB.

A native of New York City, Sister Ferguson entered the Sisters of St. Joseph of Rochester in 1916 from St. Vincent Ferrer Parish, New York City. She received her teachers' training at Nazareth Normal School, which was conducted by the SSJ's, and later began a teach-

ing career that spanned 57 years. Sister Ferguson taught in several schools in the Rochester diocese, serving principally in the primary grades. She opened a kindergarten at St. Paul's Academy, Oswego, in 1935 and another in 1940 at Immaculate Conception in Ithaca, where she remained for 20 years.

Sister Ferguson then moved on to teach the kindergarten at Nazareth Hall Cadet School from 1960 until 1973. Then she returned to Ithaca for one more year of teaching before she retired from active service. She remained in Ithaca for another five years, until ill health forced her to return to the motherhouse and infirmary in Rochester.

During her career, Sister Ferguson also

taught at St. Bridget's, Holy Apostles, St. Ambrose and St. Patrick's Girls' Home, all in Rochester; St. Peter and Paul, Elmira; Holy Trinity, Webster; and St. Michael's, Penn Yan.

Sister Ferguson is remembered for her happy disposition, love of people and eagerness to participate in joyous occasions, which she enlivened with her wit and piano playing. Sister Ferguson loved her native city of New York, and was always delighted to return for visits or to have her family visit her. She said, however, that she never knew of trees or grass until she came to Rochester.

Sister Ferguson is survived by one sister-in-law, Lillian Ferguson of Glen Cove, and by several nieces, nephews, grandnieces and grand-nephews.
