Sister Wilmett Waterhouse, SSJ

A Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated Saturday, July 25, for Sister Wilmett Waterhouse of the Sisters of St. Joseph. Sister Waterhouse died in St. Joseph Convent Infirmary on Thursday, July 23, 1987, at the age of 86.

Sister Waterhouse entered the Sisters of St. Joseph of Rochester in 1938 from St. Augustine's Parish, Rochester. She earned a baccalaureate degree from the University of Rochester, a master's degree from Nazareth College and a degree in library science from , Syracuse University.

Before her entrance into the Sisters of St. Joseph, Sister Waterhouse did a great deal of traveling with her parents. Among the highlights of these excursions was an audience with Pope Piux XI and seeing the Passion Play at Oberammergau, Germany.

Among the Rochester elementary schools in which she taught were: St. Francis Xavier, St. Theodore, St. Agnes Grammar School, St. Anne, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Ambrose and Mother of Sorrows, all of Rochester; St. John the Evangelist, Spencerport; Nativity, Brockport; St. Paul, Oswego; and St. Mary, Auburn.

In 1967, Sister Waterhouse became the librarian at Nazareth Academy, where she re-

mained until her retirement in 1981. She moved to St. Joseph Convent Infirmary in 1983.

Msgr. Donovan, Geneseo native

Monsignor William J. Donovan, a Geneseo native, died Sunday, July 12, 1987, in an Aurora, Ill., nursing home at the age of 102.

Born in 1884, Monsignor Donovan grew up in Rochester and Canandaigua, and was ordained in the Diocese of Buffalo. Shortly after his ordination in 1913, Monsignor Donovan was recruited to serve in the newly created Diocese of Rockford, Ill. He returned to Rochester in 1923 and taught English at the Aquinas Institute. Sister Emerita Hagerty,

A Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated Monday, July 27, for Sister Emerita Hagerty of the Sisters of St. Joseph. Sister Hagerty died in St. Joseph Convent Infirmary on Friday, July 24, 1987, at the age of 86.

A native of Rochester, Sister Hagerty entered the Sisters of St. Joseph of Rochester in 1918 from Holy Rosary Parish, Rochester. She was a graduate of Nazareth Academy and of Nazareth Normal School, a teachers' college conducted by the Sisters of St. Joseph.

Sister Hagerty taught in various schools in the Diocese of Rochester for 51 years, including an 18-year stint at Sacred Heart Cathedral School. She also spent seven years at both St. Francis Xavier, Rochester, and St. Stephen's, Geneva. Sister Hagerty also taught at St. Monica, Holy Apostles, St. Pius X, Mother of Sorrows and St. Augustine, all of Rochester; as well as St. John's, Spencerport, St. Agnes. Avon, and St. Patrick's, Seneca Falls.

Sister Hagerty is remembered for her great sense of humor.

For more than 35 years, Monsignor Donovan was pastor of Holy Cross Parish in Batavia, Ill. After retiring as pastor, he lived on at the Holy Cross Rectory until just two months before his death, when he moved to a nursing home.

Bishop Arthur J. O'Neill of the Rockford Diocese presided at a Mass of Christian Burial for Monsignor Donovan on Thursday, July 16, 1987, in Holy Cross Church. He was buried at Resurrection Cemetery in Batavia.






