

Principals meeting to prepare for new year

As another school year is about to begin, the principals of the Catholic schools throughout the Diocese of Rochester are preparing for the opening day of school. On September 1, they will attend a special meeting with Brother Brian Walsh, superintendent of schools, and the general education staff to discuss plans and special programs for the school year.

New principals have several meetings scheduled to give them direction as well as necessary help and support for the beginning of the new school year. These are only a few of the many meetings that take place behind the scenes in the workings of the diocesan educational system.

An excellent means of communication was instituted 19 years ago with the formation of the diocesan Principal's Association. Every principal throughout the diocese attends one of seven regional meetings conducted each month. These meetings focus on a wide range of educational concerns, including standardized testing; new state laws and regula-

tions; new curricula, with heavy emphasis upon the religion curriculum; topics for in-service training of teachers; and trends in education.

One member of each regional principals' association represents the group at the monthly meeting of the diocese-wide Principals' Federation, which also includes the superintendent of schools and selected members of the general education staff. These meetings provide for two-way communication between the principals and the general education office, giving principals and diocesan staff an opportunity to discuss major projects that are being implemented in the diocesan schools.

The new principals participated in a July 14-15 orientation program on Catholic school philosophy, leadership in the school faith community, leadership in the area of basic skills, and curriculum.

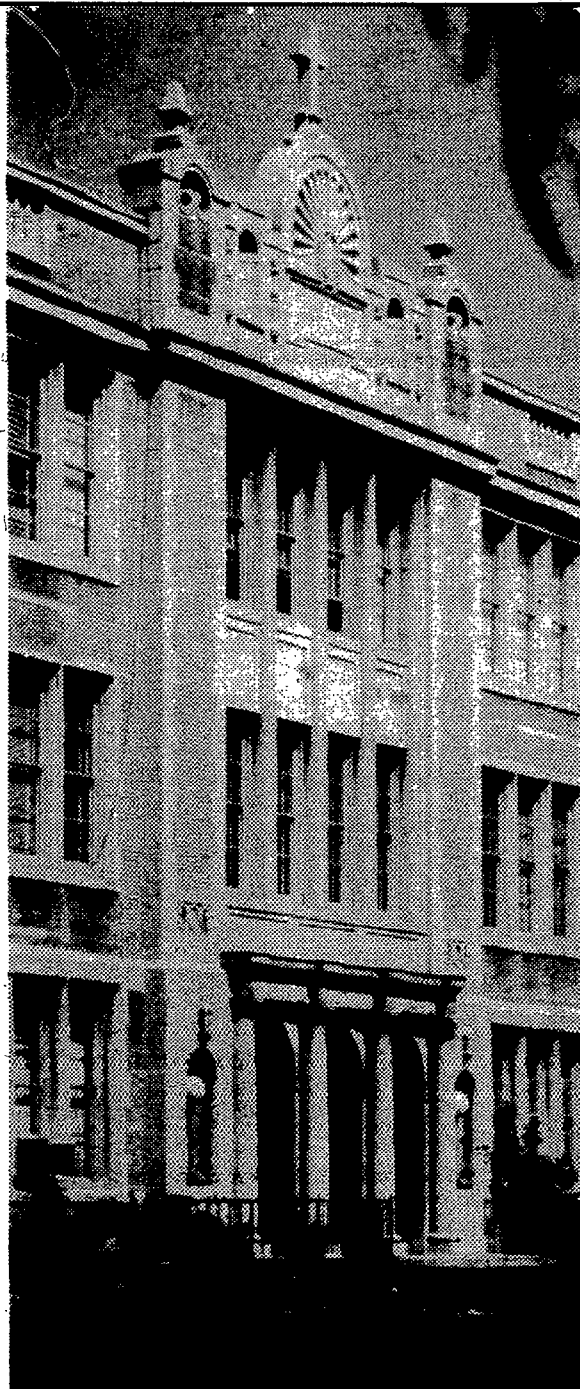

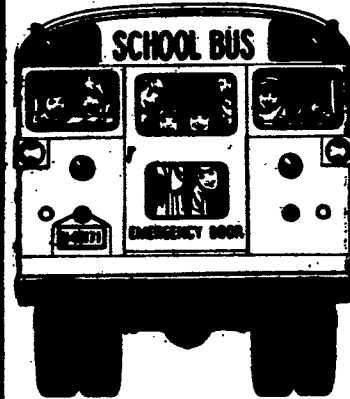
