



PEACE LANTERNS — To mark the 42nd anniversary of the bombings of Hiroshima and Nagasaki, Japan, residents of St. Paul, Minn., float paper peace lanterns on the Mississippi River. The custom stems from the Japanese tradition of floating lanterns on rivers to guide ancestral souls back to the land of the dead. But since World War II the lanterns have taken on a new meaning to memorialize the deaths from the atomic bombs. More than 100 U.S. cities and 60 foreign countries held lantern floats earlier this month.
