Father Anthony P. Lococo, former AQ teacher

Father Anthony P. Lococo, CSB, who served on the faculty of Aquinas Institute from 1938 to 1958, died in Toronto, Ontario, on August 29, 1987.

Father Lococo was born in Niagara Falls, Ontario, Canada, to the late Philip and Loretta Lococo on October 18, 1937. After entering the Congregation of St. Basil in 1933, he was ordained to the priesthood in December, 1937. He taught Latin, Italian and theology during his days at Aquinas Institute, while serving as moderator of the scholastics.

Father Lococo subsequently was master of novices for the congregation, president of St. Charles College in Sudbury, Ontario, and most recently guidance teacher at Michael Power High School, Toronto.

In keeping with the pastoral spirit of the local Basilian Community, Father Lococo celebrated Mass each Sunday during World War II at the Sampson Naval Training Station.

The Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated September 1 at St. Basil College Chapel, with interment at Holy Cross Cemetery, Toronto.

Mrs. Gillette was a member of the Legion of Mary, the Rochester Association of the United Nations, the University of Rochester In-

ternational Students Association, Red Cross Grey Ladies, the Rochester Speakers Bureau and numerous other church and civic organizations.

She is survived by two sisters, Madalyn Monagan and Ruth Riorden; one brother, George McCullough; two sons and daughters-in-law, S. Frank and Dorothy Gillette of Connecticut, and James H. and Lita Gillette of Brockport; one daughter and son-in-law, Shirley and Richard McMahon of Homer; as well as 17 grandchildren; 23 great grandchildren; and several nieces and nephews.
