Sister Joselita Kalb, SSJ; known for kindly manner

Mass of Christian Burial for Sister Joselita Kalb of the Sisters of St. Joseph was celebrated in the motherhouse chapel by Father Peter T. Bayer on October 13, 1987. Sister Kalb died on October 9, 1987, in St. Joseph's Convent Infirmary. She was 89 years of age.

In her greeting to the congregation during the funeral liturgy, Sister Elizabeth Anne LeValley, the congregation's superior general, spoke of Sister Kalb's life of simplicity and humility, fidelity to a hidden life of prayer, and service and kindly living in community — a reflection of the manner in which she had "lived" her name Joselita meaning "Little

Joseph." Sister Kalb, born Rose Kalb; wa a native of Rochester. She entered the Sisters of St. Joseph from St. Boniface Parish in 1918. Sister Kalb was a graduate of Nazareth Normal School and held a life certificate from the state of New York for teaching in elementary schools.

She began her teaching career in 1920 and continued until 1970. Over the years, she taught in several schools — Holy Trinity, Webster, for 12 years; St. Anthony, Elmira, for 11 years; St. Patrick, Seneca Falls for nine years; and for shorter periods of time at Immaculate Conception, St. Ambrose, Holy Apostles, Nazareth

Hall and St. Monica of Rochester; St. Alphonsus, Auburn; St. Mary, Dansville; St. Mary, Canandaigua; St. Stephen, Geneva; and St. Patrick, Corning.

In 1970, Sister Joselita returned from teaching and took up residence in the SSJ motherhouse, where she remained until failing health caused her to move to St. Joseph's Convent Infirmary in 1977.

Sister Kalb is survived by one sister, Agnes Kalb of Rochester; two nephews, Walter and Lawrence Kalb of Rochester; grandnices, grandnephews and cousins.

Raymond Statt, longtime St. Augustine's parishioner

Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated October 8, 1987, for Raymond W. Statt. His son, Father Thomas R. Statt, pastor of Our Mother of Sorrows Church, presided and homilized at the concelebrated Mass at St. Augustine's Church. Joining Father Statt in the rites were Bishop Joseph L. Hogan, retired bishop of Rochester, who gave the final absolution, and many priest classmates and friends from the dioceses of Rochester and Syracuse. Interment was in the family plot at Holy Sepulchre Cemetery.

Mr. Statt died October 4, 1987, at St. Ann's Home, where he had resided since September 1. He was 97 years old.

Mr. Statt had been a sales representative for the Florsheim Shoe Company for 34 years, prior to his retirement in 1953. His territory included the states of Michigan and New York,

with the exception of New York City. For 21 years, he was the Chicago firm's top salesman in the nation. He was also the first company representative to travel by private car rather than by train.

He was a member of St. Augustine's Church for 57 years and a charter member of Brook-Lea Country Club in Gafes. He was also a Fourth-Grade member of the Rochester Assembly of the Knights of Columbus.

Mr. Statt's wife of 54 years, the late Elizabeth Gleason Statt, died on July 30, 1984. In addition to his son, Mr. Statt is survived by four daughters — Mary Elizabeth Surmon and Nancy A. Heffernan of Rochester, Ellen S. Quinn of Fayetteville, N.Y. and Sister Rosemary Statt, RSCJ, of Kenya, East Africa — four grandchildren, and several nieces and nephews.
