

### Fair offers holiday alternatives

St. Mary Our Mother, Horseheads - The social ministry committee will host a Harvest Dinner and Alternative Christmas Idea Fair Saturday, Nov. 14, from 5-7 p.m. in the auditorium and gymnasium.

The fair will feature information about how the celebration of Christmas can be good news for the poor, both locally and throughout the world. Organizations will offer cards and gifts crafted by families in Third-World countries, as well as details about how to send such families a "gift of life."
