established, but Father William B. Leone, pastor of Holy Redeemer/St. Francis Xavier, said that his parish could not afford the \$9,000 insurance payment due in July, and implied that the church may be razed sometime this spring. The church has been vacant since 1985 when Holy Redeemer Parish merged with that of nearby St. Francis Xavier.

The school building is not scheduled for demolition, as the diocese is continuing negotiations with the Rochester City School District, which has indicated interest in buying the school and the surrounding land after the church, rectory and heating facility are demolished.

In front of the church on Hudson and Clifford Avenues just two hours after the diocese made its announcement, representatives of the Landmark Society and the Friends of Holy Redeemer expressed anger at the process the diocese used to make its decision and vowed not to give up their fight.

"Never once did we meet face to face," said Boehler. "You can't go around playing tag. For four months we've tried to sit down with them (diocesan officials). We were dealing in good faith, I thought they were

Some of his most heated comments were directed at Bishop Matthew H. Clark, who Boehler said "seemed to be more concerned

with the canonization of Charlie Curran' than one of his own churches.

Bishop Clark disagreed with Boehler's claims, saying that the issue had been debated for so long that his presence would have been "counterproductive to the decision-making process."

Boehler questioned whether Father Leone was totally in favor of the decision to demolish the church. The priest, however, said he believes "strongly that we have made the best decision possible under the present

"The entire issue has become a justice issue," Father Leone commented. "It is unfair for an inner-city parish such as Holy Redeemer/St. Francis Xavier to have to use the limited funds its good people are donating faithfully to the parish to maintain payment of city-use taxes and high insurance premiums, on deteriorating and unused buildings.'

Boehler said that Friends of Holy Redeemer, which has been working closely with the Landmark Society of Western New York, will pursue several legal options to continue its effort to save one of Rochester' oldest German churches. He declined to elaborate on what those options might be.
