# The Catholic School: Its Roots, Identity and Future

This is a review of the book, *The Catholic School: Its Roots, Identity and Future* by Father Harold A. Buetow. It is published by Crossroads Publishers (New York, 1988).

The title aptly expresses the purpose and content of this book. In contrast to objections both theoretical and practical to the value of the Catholic school in contemporary America, Father Harold A. Buetow presents a ringing defense and apologia for it.

His focus is on the identity of the Catholic school. If this identity is properly understood and appreciated, then sufficient support would be readily available to enable the Catholic schools not only to survive but to flourish.

To discern and describe this identity, Father Buetow examines the goals and curriculum of the school as well as the pertinent agents involved in schooling and education: family, church, state, teachers, students. In this examination he uses insights from not only educational theory, but also from philosophy, theology, law, psychology and sociology.

Of most compelling interest to me were the chapters on the opponents of Catholic schools and on the state's role, for often enough current governmental policy in the United States puts the government, at every level, in the camp of the opponents.

In these two chapters, Father Buetow calls attention to the radical role secular humanists in general and the American Civil Liberties Union and the totally misnamed People for the American Way play in opposing Catholic schools.

He correctly points out that public schools, which were once Protestant schools, have now become secular hu-

manist schools. This is all the more important since, as Father Buetow shows so well, Catholic schools are fully in keeping with the origins and original intentions and insights of the United States as an independent nation.

There are many interesting insights, of which only a few can be mentioned here. I am sure that pope, bishops and Roman curial officials will be surprised to learn that in the Church "authority flows from the bottom to the top."

The very interesting section on leadership would have benefitted from philosopher G.H. Mead's theory of the "significant other," but Father Buetow's refusal to allow all Church leadership to be located in the hierarchy and religious is well taken.

His description of the chaos and confusion which reign in the American courts about the role and rights of families and voluntary associations cannot be praised too much.

All in all, this book can only be recommended. It should be read above all by the Catholic bishops of the United States, who need to give more serious support to Catholic schools. This point is not made as strongly by Father Buetow as it might have been. It is all very well to extol other educational strategies, but no serious alternative to the Catholic schools has been suggested by anyone.

One hopes that he will prepare a shorter and less detailed version and that a publisher will then push this book vigorously, for it deserves a much wider audience than its present scholarly format will in all likelihood receive.
