Margaret O'Donnell, Irondequoit teacher

Mass of Christian Burial for Margaret M. O'Donnell was celebrated at St. Therese of the Little Flower Church in Syracuse on Tuesday, May 24. The Mass was concelebrated by Father Edward J. Reimer, pastor of St. Therese's, and O'Donnell's godson, Father Robert J. Kanka, pastor of St. James the Apostle Church, Trumansburg.

Miss O'Donnell died May 21, 1988, at the age of 91.

Originally a Syracuse native, Miss O'Donnell began teaching at the Abraham Lincoln School in East Irondequoit in 1923. In 1957, she became the school's principal, a position she held until her retirement in 1965. At the school's 50th anniversary celebration, a wing of the school was named in her honor.

A graduate of Cortland Normal School,

Miss O'Donnell earned a bachelor of science degree from the University of Rochester in 1957. Throughout her career, she continued to take courses at such educational institutions as Columbia Teachers' College, Penn State University, and Plattsburgh, Geneseo and Brockport state teachers' colleges.

Miss O'Donnell was a member of the New York State Retired Teachers Association and other professional organizations.

While living in Rochester, she resided with her sister and brother-in-law, the late Mary and William Kinney of Pittsford. She was an active member of St. Louis Parish, Pittsford, until she returned to Syracuse in 1979.

Miss O'Donnell is survived by many nieces and nephews living in the Syracuse area.

Sister Ann (Mary) Roy, native of Rochester

Sister Anita (Mary) Roy, a native Rochesterian, died on May 19, 1988, at the Spaulding Rehabilitation Center in South Boston, Mass., after a short illness. She was 60.

Sister Roy was director of the Loblouche Center Early Childhood Services Program in South Boston for the past 13 years.

After entering the Daughters of Charity in 1945, Sister Roy served in seven cities in five states.

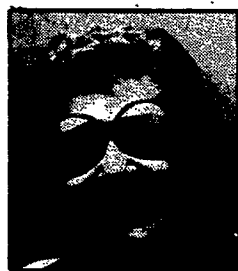
She is survived by her mother, Mary Roy of

Nurnberg elected head of ecumenical council



Margery Nurnberg, director of the diocesan Department of Ecumenical and Interreligious Affairs, was elected president of Genesee Ecumenical Ministries on Wednesday, June 1.

Nurnberg becomes the third lay person and only the second Catholic to serve as the president of the organization since its foundation in 1970. Bishop Matthew H. Clark served as president from 1980 to 1982.

Nurnberg's term is for one year, although she is eligible for more than one term. She succeeds the Rev. James Rice, a member of the staff of the Presbytery of Genesee Valley.

Also elected to a GEM office was Kenneth K. Maher, justice and peace director for the Genesee Valley Office of Social Ministry. He will serve as GEM's vice president for social witness and service.

The other new GEM officers are: the Rev. James C. Miller, vice president for operations; the Rev. Bruce Hanson, vice president for ecumenical relations; the Rev. Donald Roth, treasurer; and Myron Sunderland, secretary.

Mary A. Hctor, taught at Good Counsel school

Mrs. Mary A. Hctor, who taught at Our Lady of Good Counsel School from 1952 to 1963, died on April 22, 1988, at St. Ann's Home in Rochester. She was 91.

A Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated by her son, Father Thomas D. Hctor, on April 25 at St. Ann's Home chapel. Father Hctor was assisted by Father Francis M. Feeney, former pastor of St. James Church in Rochester.

Born in Brooklyn on January 20, 1897, Mrs. Hctor and her family moved to Rochester several years later. She attended Corpus Christi School before moving on to Nazareth Academy, from which she graduated in 1913.

After graduating from Rochester Normal School on University Avenue in 1917, Mrs. Hctor taught at School No. 6 (site of the recently closed St. Anthony's School) from 1918

to 1930. Mrs. Hctor's 11 years at Good Counsel School left a lasting impression on everyone she met.

"I still meet people who recognize my name and remember her as a first grade teacher; she always taught the first grade," said Father Hctor, who is chaplain at the Rochester Psychiatric Center. "She was very well known for her teaching ability."

Mrs. Hctor was a former parishioner of St. Anne's, St. Theodore's and Corpus Christi parishes.

She is survived by her daughter, Sister Marion Hctor, SSJ, of the Nazareth College faculty; two sons, Father Hctor, of Rochester; and Arthur of McKinny, Texas; five grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.
