that a limited research program can continue, but that it is not morally acceptable to move toward deployment of the system.

In a surprise action, the bishops approved a two-year contract to use Mother Angelica's Eternal Word Television Network as the exclusive cable outlet for programs produced by the bishops conference.

The bishops also discussed the first draft of the pastoral letter on women in the Church and society. In their discussion, the bishops criticized some aspects of the draft, but many of their suggestions were requests

In other actions, the bishops:

• Criticized inadequacies in a draft Vatican document on the theological and juridical status of bishops' conferences, and formed a blue-ribbon panel of bishops to

write a response to it;

Debated general absolution at length, but came to an inconclusive vote on a norm for its use in the United States;

• Decided on an allocation plan to distribute an estimated \$20 million a year — which they plan to collect in the nation's parishes — to help meet critical retirement needs of men and women religious;

 Voted down a proposal to pursue negotiations to join a new ecumenical cable television network called VISN.
