Pat J. Donofrio, 71; parish, school supporter

Mass of Christian Burial for Pat J. Donofrio, former president of National Paper Company, was celebrated in Holy Apostles Church on Friday, July 29, at 9 a.m. Father Benedict A. Ehmman celebrated the Mass.

Mr. Donofrio died Monday, July 25, in his home following a long illness. He was 71.

Known among friends and family members as "Lanky," Mr. Donofrio was born in Rochester and graduated from West High School. He was a decorated veteran of World War II, serving in the 1st Marine Division.

Mr. Donofrio began work with the National Paper Company as a salesman in 1934. Advancing to the position of sales manager, he later became president of the company prior to its closing in 1979. Afterward, he continued to serve selected accounts with Rochester Paper Company.

In 1958, Mr. Donofrio helped to found the North West Youth Baseball Association, and served as president until 1970. He was active

Dom Jean Vianney Laflamme, former Cistercian abbot, at 72

Dom Jean Vianney Laflamme, OSCO, died Saturday, July 16, 1988, at the infirmary of the Abbey of the Genesee at Piffard, N.Y.

Born Joseph Laflamme on August 4, 1915, he entered the novitiate at Mistassini, Quebec, in April, 1934, taking the name Jean Vianney. Twenty four years after his solemn profession in 1941, he was elected abbot of the community at Mistassini.

Having retired in 1965, Dom Laflamme made stability at the Abbey of the Genesee in

in Boy Scouts from 1958 until 1970.

An active member of Holy Apostles Parish, Mr. Donofrio assisted with parish carnivals and fund-raising events. He was a life-long supporter of the Sisters of St. Joseph, of which his sister, Sister Ann d'Assisi of Nazareth Hall, is a member. He was also one of the original members of the St. Agnes High School Fathers Club, and a member of the Cardinal Mooney High School Fathers Club.

He is survived by his wife of 49 years, Mary; two sons, William and Patrick Jr.; two daughters and sons-in-law, Patricia and Vincent Del-Gudico, and Mary Anne and Robert Sailer; a daughter-in-law, Jean Verno; three brothers, Anthony and Louis of Rochester and Alfred of Texas; four sisters, Sister Ann d'Assisi, Yolanda Ruggerio, and Eleanor Piendel of Rochester, and Jane Passino of Florida; eight grandchildren; one great-grandchild; and several nieces and nephews.
