making power."

For those people angered by the Church's treatment of women, Gallagher believes Mary's Pence can provide an alternative. "We're not in competition with Peter's Pence. If there are Catholic people out there who are so angry with the Catholic Church that they are backing away, we're giving them a way to stay connected."

On the other hand, a brochure mailed to potential supporters this summer includes a coupon for use "in some way to notify Church officials" of the choice to contribute to Mary's Pence. Gallagher explained that the coupon is

not intended as a protest, but as a means of information for those to whom the conventional means of access to local bishops may be closed. "We hope that in this way the bishops will see that there is an organization out there and they will support it — especially with the pastoral coming out," she said.

"The lack of awareness among local clergy is practically incredulous — they have no idea of what the lack of funding can do," Muschal-Reinhardt added. "(The coupon) is an attempt to make them aware, to raise the consciousness of people to what the lack of funding does."

Donations to Mary's Pence already exceed \$25,000. And true to the foundation's grassroots nature, contributors — ranging from priests and whole parishes to an 84-year-old woman from County Cork, Ireland — give an average of \$10.

In addition to soliciting individual contributions, Mary's Pence organizers are urging women to request parish second collections to benefit the foundation, to invite speakers on the topic to parish or neighborhood groups, and to plan fundraising events.

Meanwhile, the foundation, which has pledged to distribute all donated funds in grants beginning this fall, has already received more than 37 requests from programs ranging from storefront legal services in Oakland, Calif., to a New York City group that helps the homeless develop self-esteem and a sense of community through Bible study. "We knew there was a need, but we didn't realize how great the need would be," Gallagher said.

In spite of the generous response by donors, the future of Mary's Pence is overshadowed by the need to find funds to meet administrative

costs. Gallagher noted that secular organizations won't consider funding Mary's Pence because it is Catholic. Catholic foundations, on the other hand, have not responded, Gallagher said, "because they don't understand how we are Church with no diocesan affiliation, all women on the board, and no letter from the Cardinal (Joseph Bernardin of the Archdiocese of Chicago)."
