Catholic schools and of parish religious-education programs. "Now, for the first time, we are working together," she said. "I look for a sharing of sacramental training and liturgical celebrations. This will enrich parish life."

Father Joseph M. Jankowiak, pastor of St. Mary's, did raise a question about the effect the cluster formation will have on hiring practices, pointing out that in previous practice priority was placed on hiring school teachers in preference to such other educational personnel as directors of religious education.

Responding to that question, Bishop Clark said that specifics for hiring practices will be worked out by the clusters. He noted, howev-

er, that decisions of that sort will have to be made in light of overall regional needs, and that "it may well be that schools will have to be changed."

Sister Roberta Tierney, director of the Division of Education, said it would be appropriate for the cluster board to make such a hiring decision, and noted that the board might well decide that the cluster has a greater need for the religious education director than for the teacher. Sister Tierney also pointed out that with the cluster approach, such decisions can be made involving several parishes, thus making it possible for parishes to share educational personnel. A director of religious education might well serve two or three parishes that previously could not afford separately to hire full-time, qualified coordinators, she said.

Father David Gramke, pastor of St. John the Baptist Parish in Elmira, applauded Sister Tierney's explanation of the comprehensive nature of the cluster plan.

"When she spoke of 'full scope' in education to include not only Catholic schools, but adult education, sacramental training, programs for youth and young adults, Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults, that is a new dimension, and a new direction for us in education," he said.
