## **Teachers**

to control rising costs. Diocesan teachers with decades of experience command less than the starting salaries for their counterparts in many public school districts. Nevertheless, the difference between diocesan-recommended salaries for a first-year Catholic school teacher and one with 18 years' experience and comparable education is a budget-busting \$7,125 - \$7,500 inside Monroe County.

Experienced teachers are worth the financial sacrifice, according to Dan Hurley, principal at St. Mary Our Mother School in Horseheads, where both Wilson and Cleveland applied last June. Hurley said he had no teacher openings at the time.

When he returned from a summer-study program and learned of several resignations on St. Mary's school staff, Hurley quickly contacted both women, who had deeply impressed him. "These are two very, very good teachers. Our school and our children are going to benefit," he said.

Because Cleveland and Wilson are replac-

ing staff members with considerably fewer years in the diocesan system, their salaries are not accounted for in Hurley's budget. "Obviously, their two salaries will mean a substantial increase over what we paid the two people that left," Hurley said. "But for us, the question of justice was far greater than any financial need ... We'll manage somehow."

Formerly a fourth-grade teacher, Cleveland will teach some sixth- and seventh-grade classes at St. Mary Our Mother in addition to taking an eighth grade homeroom. Wilson, who has taught first grade for most of her 18-year ca-

reer, will serve as a special needs teacher with duties ranging from first, second, and thirdgrade remedial work to fourth-grade language, science and spelling.

"It'll be a challenge, but I think maybe that's good," Wilson said.

Neither the challenge of starting over nor the 25-mile drive the teachers will face to Horseheads each day can diminish their relief at finding jobs. "I wanted to stay with the diocese," Wilson said. "After you've been there all those years, you'd kind of like to stay where you're at?"
