Sophomore Jeff Shepanski hopes to carry on his athletic career at Aquinas Institute. "I don't want to leave, but if I got to, I got to," he said. "Being a junior, it'll be hard meeting new friends." Shepanski, a varsity wrestler, said he also regrets that Aquinas has no wrestling team. "Hopefully, I'll make the football team at Aquinas," he said.

Ben Leyer, also a sophomore, said he'll miss Mooney's peaceful environment. "Coming to Mooney was kind of a shelter," he said. "It made it easier to adjust." Next year, Leyer will have to adjust to Greece-Arcadia.

Adjusting to the closing could have been easier had it been announced earlier in the school year, said Phil Paschal of the class of '91.

"I wish we had a little more notice," he said, adding, however, "I think (the administration) handled it really well." Unlike many of the Mooney students who disdained the possible sale of the school building to the Greece Central School District, Paschal welcomed it.

"I'd rather it still be a school so I can drive by and say, 'Hey, I went to that school,' instead of 'Hey, I went to that bank,'" he said.

fun of. We can be who we are."

One teacher enjoys teaching children about values, and another likes the discipline of Catholic schools. Madonia joked that it's easier to discipline Catholic school students "because you've got God."

Cancilla said that all the teachers she meets in the Catholic school system are happy with their jobs. "They really like what they're doing," she remarked. She also praised the parish's home/school association. "I've never seen an organization so small that worked so hard."

Each of the St. Salome teachers said leaving their school will be like leaving a family. As they talked, the four teachers tossed around theories as to why Catholic schools are closing.

Madonia said the beginning of the end was "when we started to have to mimic the public schools with all their thousands of dollars," and noted that increased spending came as a response to parents' perception that Catholic schools — lacking field trips, large gymnasiums and other amenities — were somehow inferior.

"We should've accentuated our positive — that we provide a good Christian-centered education," she said.

And on that hopeful note, the teachers finished their lunches, swapping ideas about where they might be able to continue giving students that "good Christian-centered education."
