**ROCHESTER** — St. Mark's Parish, 54 Kuhn Road, has planned several events to celebrate its 25th anniversary this year.

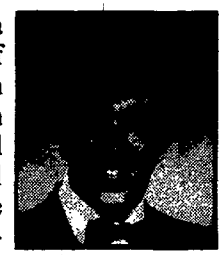
