him," Eaton explained. For now, that plan doesn't help the advertisers who lost money. Steve Tempest, business manager at St. Mary's, noted that although the parish is not legally obligated to reimburse the Canandaigua businesses that purchased ads in the non-existent programs, the parish had a moral obligation to help them retrieve their money.

"If there ever was a chance for us to try to recover their money for them, we certainly would," he said. In the future, Tempest added, the parish will check more carefully before getting involved with such enterprises.

But money is not the only commodity lost in such cases; religious organizations also suffer a loss of trust with the public. Contributors may hesitate to donate to legitimate charities for fear of being stung, and Catholic charitable organizations and foundations have consequently been forced to prove their credibility.

The Diocese of Rochester has been fortunate in avoiding major scams in recent years, observed Mark Seeberg, director of the diocesan Department of Development. Moreover, he said, the diocese has not en-

countered any fundraising problems as a result of fears caused by scams.

"Our most visible form of fundraising is the Thanks Giving Appeal, and that has built-in credibility with (Bishop Matthew H. Clark) speaking for it," he said.

Seeberg acknowledged, however, that fear of fraud could affect potential donors

to other diocesan fundraising ventures — such as the retirement fund for women religious and the endowment fund for Catholic schools.

Whether or not scams affect diocesan-level fundraising efforts, Seeberg said, the loss to individuals and parishes is reason for worry. "It's a concern that this goes

on, and people in the community get burned by this," he said.

Speaking as one who apparently did get burned, Simmons is less disappointed by his own loss to the bingo program than by that of St. Mary's.

"It bothers me that the school got nothing," he said.

grader said of serving on the altar. "It teaches you to listen to the Gospel and stuff and how to be a better person."

During the weekdays, Guck may run into Dori Ann Cimino, who supervises the Holy Family School cafeteria. Cimino is paid by the Rochester City School District to work 17 hours a week, although she noted that her job takes more time than that.

Cimino also works at bingo on Wednesday nights, makes baptismal garments for infants, and serves as Holy Family's representative on the Southwest Quadrant Planning Board, one of four such boards reorganizing Monroe County's Catholic Schools.

When asked why she is so devoted to her parish and the school, the mother of two Holy Family students replied as if the answer were a given. "Without the volunteers, who's going to run everything?" she asked. She also had little patience for those who value Catholic education, but do

nothing to help out at the schools. "If you can't keep (the school) going, don't say anything when it closes," she said.

Considering its strong, committed core of volunteers and workers, Holy Family Parish is in little danger of closing. Deacon Coccia speculated that faith in God is the underlying reason each parishioner spends his or her free time helping out at the parish or taking a low-paying job in one of its buildings.

"You can't help but always draw volunteers, once there's a community of faith," he said.

# Application materials ready for Campaign for Human Development national grants
