During 15 years as a teacher, she worked

at Our Lady of Mercy High School, Rochester, and Holy Family School, Auburn. For half a year, she was principal at Holy Family before moving in 1976 to St. Mary's, Bath, where she served as principal until the school closed in 1987.

Sister Zimmer was the Mercy community's supervisor of elementary schools from 1955-62; a diocesan supervisor of elementary schools from 1962-65; coordinator of Chemung County elementary schools from 1968-70; and diocesan regional superintendent of Southern Tier schools, 1970-76.

Since 1987, she has worked as St. Mary's religious education administrator.

said, adding that complaints against the system tend to arise from displeasure with the way the diocese allocates TGA funds, rather than from the TGA itself.

On the other hand, Father William Hart, pastor of Holy Trinity in Webster, said that the old assessment system didn't burden parishes with as much work as is required by the TGA.

"I think the diocesan assessment in the old days was rather easier," he said. "The

TGA quotas are ... more difficult to (meet)," he said, noting that his parish failed to raise its quota last year.

Father Shatzel noted that one of Bishop Clark's original intentions for the appeal — that of establishing more communication between the diocese and its people — has come to fruition in his parish.

He credited the TGA's public-relations campaign — with its brochures and videotape presentation — for spreading awareness of diocesan programs. "I hope that's something better than having to listen to me from the pulpit," he said.

Appeal Director, Patrick Sullivan, and his secretary, Nancy Nash. Seeberg said he could not cite specific figures on the portions of Sullivan's and Nash's salaries included in this figure, but noted that the time Sullivan and Nash spend on TGA activity overlaps with other duties not directly related to the appeal.

• \$79,068 for production of volunteer manuals and kits; statistical reports and pledge reminders; and mailing costs for

126,000 brochures.

These figures add up to a sum of \$147,705 — the diocesan allocation for TGA expenses this year.

In addition to the above figures, \$38,800 will be spent on accounting and billing for TGA pledges, and \$49,226 on data processing. These two figures are included in the budgets of the diocesan departments of financial services and information systems.

All together, the diocese will spend \$235,731 to administer the TGA.
