A few voices muttered Clements' name. "Then watch him," Teta said. Teta looked at his players' faces. "It's 7-7," he said encouragingly. "We can move the ball on this team."

The halftime statistics supported Teta's contention. Kearney's offense — led by Massaquoi's 77 yards — pounded out 123 yards on the ground.

"You didn't think this was going to be a picnic," Teta declared. "This is what we came here for. We came here to play a football game."

## Turning point

Ingoglia, who had been averaging 150 yards a game, was held to just 26 yards in the first half.

The junior running back was hampered by a torn groin muscle he suffered during practice on Tuesday. He had been undergoing therapy since, and had not practiced.

The third quarter opened with the Kings' defense continuing to stifle the Reds' offense. Clements found very few holes to scamper through, as he finished the game with only 75 yards on the ground.

Meanwhile, Kearney continued to move the ball without scoring. Ingoglia seemed to overcome his rustiness, and started to find holes in the Reds' defense.

But the Kings' offense was stalled repeatedly by penalties.

So Kearney turned again and again to its defense.

With 1:08 left in the third quarter, Ingoglia — who also plays linebacker — reached up and snared a Hernandez pass. He carried the interception 26 yards for the score.

Osier's kick was good, and Kearney had a 14-7 lead with 13 minutes to go in the game.

## 'Hit Squad'

The Kearney defense had dominated opponents all season. It had allowed only 67 points in the first eight games — an 8.4 average.

The players called themselves the "Hit Squad," a nickname they chanted during warm-ups before games. In the coaches' meeting before the title game, the coaches had passed out tee-shirts bearing the nickname to each of the players. The players wore the shirts under their uniforms.

And during the game, players along the sidelines began the chant each time the Kings faced a crucial defensive situation.

The chant became a litany in the fourth quarter.

## Reds rebuffed

Kearney's offense threatened only once in the fourth quarter. On a punt, Newark fumbled the ball away on their own 27. Kearney moved the ball to the 15, then tried a 32-yard field goal but it fell short.

Newark took over the ball at its own 15. Two penalties against Kearney — pass interference and offsides — moved the ball to the 42. The Reds then drove to Kearney 42-yard line.

Along the sidelines, the chant started. "Hit squad. Hit squad."

Kearney's cheerleaders and fans joined in. "Hit squad. Hit squad."

BK's Greg Mikell, who was forced to sit out several games because of a leg injury, was playing safety. Several passes had been thrown in his area, and he acknowledged that he had "been burned" once.

Standing at the Kearney 20-yard line,

Mikell watched Hernandez and the Newark receivers trying the same pattern that had burned him before. This time, he jumped into the air and snagged the ball with 2:30 left in the game.

Once again, however, Kearney was unable to move the ball, and had to punt.

The Reds took the ball from their own 42 to the Kearney 42. Hernandez threw the ball deep once more. Kearney's Marty Alexander was waiting, grabbing the ball at the Kings' 25 with one minute left in the game.

Kearney ran out the clock to preserve the victory.

Ingoglia — who recovered from his poor first half to grind out 85 yards on 20 carries and score the winning touchdown on the

interception — earned the game's Most Valuable Player Award.

Massaquoi was declared the game's Outstanding Offensive Back after his game-high 111 yards on 21 carries.

Kearney guard Mike Perkowski was honored as the Outstanding Offensive Lineman.

## Finished business

Before each game this season, the Kings hung a sign in their locker room. The sign said "Taking care of business." As players and coaches ran out of the locker room for pre-game warm-ups, they slapped the sign.

This fall, the Bishop Kearney football team took care of business.

Start teachers were initially coldly polite.

"They really resented someone else in the building," she said. "But I'm very stubborn German, so every morning I stuck my head in each (Head Start classroom) and said 'Good morning, good morning.' By the end of the year, they were very friendly," she said with a laugh.

Although the parish had set its heart on building a new school, Bishop Clark opposed the idea at first, citing that he could not justify building another school when he might have to close others in the city. Nonetheless, the parish pleaded, petitioned and prayed until the new building's approval was secured in early 1983, the centennial history said.

Fuehrer said that the faculty was elated upon hearing the news of the bishop's ap-

proval. "We went out and got champagne," she said.

Construction of the new school began in the summer of 1983, and Bishop Clark blessed the building's cornerstone in April of 1984. The school opened the following September.

Holy Rosary currently houses 10 classrooms, a computer room, a cafeteria/gym and a library. Two hundred students attend its K-8 classes, and 36 are enrolled in its pre-K program.

The faculty are generally enthralled with their modern building, but many still miss the old school — or at least the memories associated with it.

Carboni summed up the feelings of the faculty members towards the fiery tragedy. "It was ... a very moving time, even though it was difficult," she said. "I never could get the smell of the smoke out of my nose."
