

# Paul J. Hentschel Jr., a 'delightful gentleman,' at 73

Paul J. Hentschel Jr., described by friends and family as "a saintly person," died in Rochester Jan. 6, 1990. He was 73 years old.

His wife, Margaret (Van Tuyl) Hentschel, characterized her husband as a very strong, devout Catholic. "The richness that was Paul cannot be calculated," she said. "He was a saintly person ... a very warm, quiet and delightful gentleman."

Mr. Hentschel was born in Baltimore, Md., on Nov. 11, 1916. He was the first son and the second child in a family of 13 children.

He served in the U.S. Army in World War II from 1941 to 1945. Mr. Hentschel participated in the D-Day Plus One landing in Normandy and in the Battle of the Bulge.

After working for the Army Signal Depot in Baltimore after the war, Mr. Hentschel and his family moved to Rochester. In addition to working for Taylor Instrument Co. from 1953 to 1966, he was employed by Eastman Kodak Co. from 1966 to 1984. He retired in 1984.

Mr. Hentschel's wife said two of her husband's sisters are women religious and two of his brothers were Marianist lay brothers. An aunt, Sister Antonine Hentschel, also taught at Holy Redeemer School in Rochester.

In addition, his cousin, Bishop Matthew Neidhammer, OFM, Cap., was a Capuchin-Franciscan bishop of the Diocese of Bluefields, Nicaragua.

Mr. Hentschel was predeceased by his son, Lance Corporal Robert E. Hentschel,

who served in the U.S. Marine Corps in Vietnam in 1967. Lance Cpl. Hentschel was posthumously awarded the Navy Commendation Medal for sacrificing his life to rescue a wounded Marine.

Paul Hentschel Jr. was a member of Veterans of Foreign Wars and American Legion. Both units participated during funeral services for him at St. Augustine's Church, Rochester, on Jan. 9 and 10.

A Mass of Christian Burial for Mr. Hentschel was concelebrated by four priests: Father Robert Ring, pastor of St. Augustine's Church; Father William Trotter, former pastor of St. Joseph's and current pastor of St. Joseph's Church, Livonia; Father Francis Feeney, a friend of Mr. Hentschel's for 23 years and a friend of his wife and her parents since 1932; and

a Redemptorist priest from Edgewater, Annapolis, Md., where Mr. Hentschel's sister, Sister Marian Hentschel, serves as pastoral assistant.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Hentschel is survived by two sons, Peter and Thomas, both of Rochester; five daughters: Mary, Alice and Amy of Rochester, Rosemary of Cincinnati and Bernadette of New York City; three brothers: John, Albert and Eugene of Baltimore; five sisters: Sister Ruth (Catherine) Hentschel, OSF, of Baltimore, Sister Miriam Hentschel, MSHS, of Edgewater, Md., Rita Foard and Theresa Donohoe of Altamonte Springs, Fla.; three grandchildren; and several nieces and nephews.

to complete paperwork desired by the Vatican, while in another case, the congregation's leaders needed "a clearer reading" of their members' views on joining the institute.

Despite the delay, Sister Carle was optimistic that the remaining three congregations would join the institute before the end of the year.

Sister Miller noted that her congregation will feel no immediate effect of the institute's approval other than a "bonding" with the other congregations. She em-

phasized that the institute's formation will not change the Mercy sisters' ministries in any way.

Sister Carle said the only financial effect of the unification move would be felt in each congregation's annual assessment fee for a national Mercy sisters' endowment fund. Currently, each congregation pays an annual assessment fee according to a formula tied to its number of members. Under the new system, each community will pay an equal amount, she said, although she declined to say what that fee might be.

The Sisters of Mercy were founded in 1831 in Dublin, Ireland. The order is noted for charitable work among the sick, the aged, the orphaned, the young and the uneducated.

## Sr. Mary Metz, SSND, Holy Family teacher

NORWALK, Conn. — Sister Mary Leonilda Metz, SSND, who taught at Holy Family School in Rochester for one year, died Nov. 24, 1989, in Norwalk Hospital in Connecticut. She was 90 years old.

She was a professed member of the Society of Notre Dame for 66 years.

Born on July 13, 1899, in Newark, N.J., Sister Leonilda entered the congregation from St. Leo's Parish in Irvington, N.J.

She served as an elementary school teacher at various schools in Maryland, New Jersey and New York. In 1943, Sister Leonilda arrived at Holy Family School in Rochester after serving eight years at Holy Cross School in Albany.

She taught at Holy Family until 1944,

when she moved to St. Joseph's School in New York City. After retiring from teaching in 1985, Sister Leonilda arrived at the SSND Motherhouse in Wilton, Conn.

A Mass of Christian Burial was held on Tuesday, Nov. 28, 1989, in the motherhouse chapel. The burial was in St. Mary's Cemetery, Bethel, Conn.
