

Visions of 're-Canstruction'

Last Tuesday, construction began on the Interstate 490 overpass, the showpiece of Rochester's Can of Worms reconstruction project. Above, concrete pier caps — which will soon support the overpass's huge steel girders — span a section of 590 North. In order to hoist the 130-foot, 60-ton girders atop the pillars, workers will need to station cranes in the middle of Interstate 590, forcing nightly lane closures until mid-April.

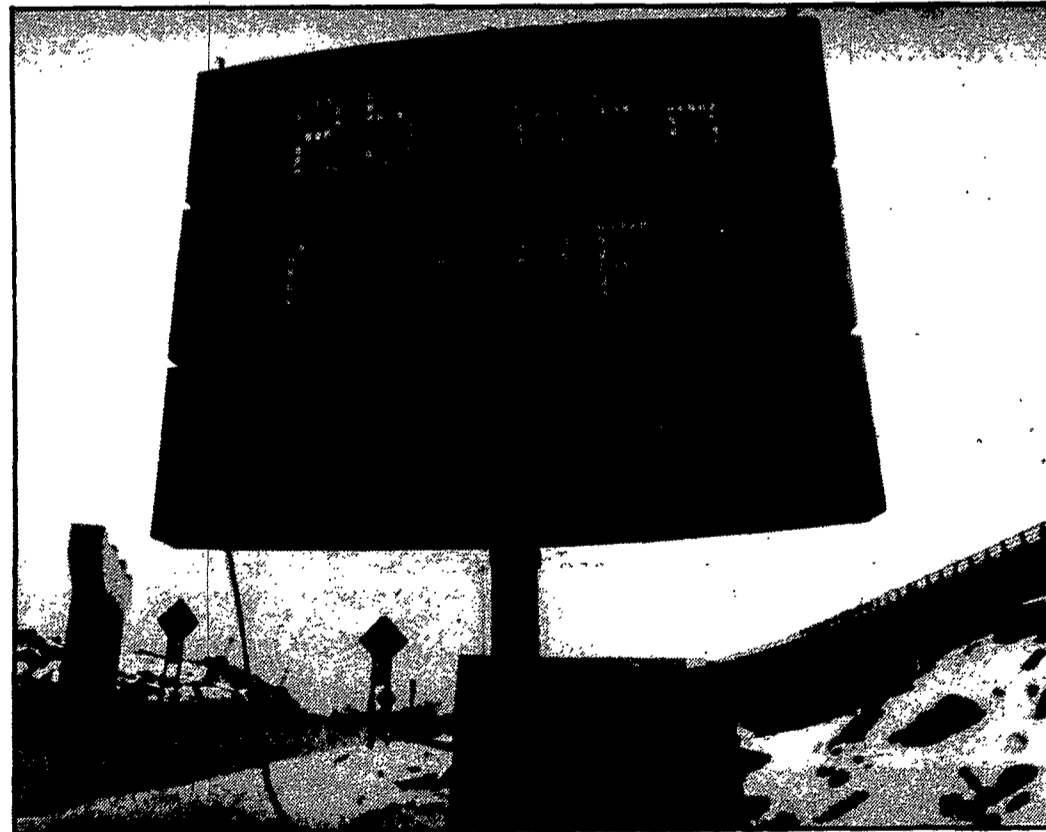
