Eleanor Krygier heard of the new Home Connection through a radio advertisement and thought her mother, Helen Chase, might enjoy it. "When I came here, I found it was very active, and they treat each other like one big family," Krygier said as she sat with the seniors.

Her mother comes to Home Connection on Mondays and Thursdays and she enjoys the busy atmosphere. "I like to make flowers — I like to socialize," Chase said.

Home Connection runs Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Up to 30 people can participate on a daily basis, with some clients opting to come only one

or two days a week, McCarthy said.

Currently, eight to 10 seniors attend each day to make use of a host of services, including personalized health care, nutritional counseling and meals, bathing and hygiene assistance, and such recreational activities as card parties, gardening, choir and discussion groups.

The program costs \$67 per day, which can be covered by Medicaid, McCarthy said; adding that Home Connection also can provide transportation if needed.

Already, the program seems to be popular with the clientele, who spoke well of St. Ann's staff.

Casey had only one complaint. Turning to McCarthy, the avid poker-player said: "The only trouble is you don't recruit any card players."
